

Congregational Meeting – On Sunday, September 28 at 10:25AM we will hold a congregational meeting for the purpose of receiving the Annual Report of Session, which will include a financial report for 2024-25 and a report on the approved budget for 2025-26 and approve changes in the pastors' terms of call.
