

The pastors are convening a new Community Conversation in the Sanctuary on Tuesday, October 14, at 6:30PM entitled, "Who Is My Enemy? Being Community in the Midst of Conflict." Our national public discourse continues to grow more and more polarized, and it has become increasingly common to consider those on "the other side" not simply as opponents or even adversaries, but as enemies. In a moderated discussion, this conversation will explore what it means to have enemies in our society and in our faith, and how we as Christians are called to engage with our enemies. This event is open to the public, so you are encouraged to invite your neighbors for this important and all-too-timely conversation.
