



The pastors are convening a new Community Conversation in the Sanctuary on Tuesday, October 14, at 6:30PM entitled, "Who Is My Enemy? Being Community in the Midst of Conflict." In a moderated discussion, this conversation will explore what it means to have enemies in our society and in our faith, and how we as Christians are called to engage with our enemies.
