





**Cecelia McKay Good Neighbor Fund -** These are difficult times for many families in the County. In the month of October, through your exceptional generosity the Cecelia McKay Fund has prevented the eviction or utility shut-off of 16 families. Through direct phone contact with 48 requests for assistance, an understanding of the specific urgency of need, and counseling of the best way forward for all of these folks, Woods ultimately provided \$3,395.94 to the 16 most needy. Though the government shut-down is over, many of those "living on the edge" in Anne Arundel County continue to need assistance due to low hours or even office closure. Woods Church along with SPAN and other area Churches are stepping up to help. You truly are Christ's "Hands and Feet" on earth.
