



Woods Adult Mission Trip

April 20 – April 25, 2026



- We will travel to Richmond, VA and work with the Richmond Metropolitan Habitat for Humanity affiliate (<https://richmondhabitat.org/>).
- We are looking for 10+ participants for the Mission Trip.
- Quick Itinerary
 - Travel to VA on Monday, April 20 (travel time about 2.5 hours).
 - On Tuesday, April 21, we will work at the Richmond ReStore.
 - Work at construction site(s) Wednesday through Saturday (4/22 – 4/25).
 - Travel home after the workday on Saturday, April 25.
- We will be housed for free at a local church with kitchen and bathroom/shower facilities available to us. We can sleep on camp-style cots provided to us by the affiliate.
- Potential work projects will be determined later.
- We are asking participants to pay \$75 per person for the trip. This is half of the amount that the Richmond HFH is requiring from us. This money helps them buy materials for the houses being built as well as provides each participant a t-shirt and one lunch.
- Meals will be prepared by our group (other than the one lunch provided and a possible dinner out) and teams will be formed to spread out the responsibilities.
- More details will be forthcoming as the mission team meets closer to the time.

 - You do not need to sign up for any particular work shifts (their Volunteer Coordinator will do that for our group).
- Each participant is asked to provide their t-shirt size as well as any food allergies. A t-shirt will be given to everyone and lunch will be provided on a day of our choosing.
- We will figure out carpooling with personal vehicles.
- We will also schedule a meeting or two prior to the trip so the entire group can get together to discuss plans.
