Each October, the Catholic Church in the United States celebrates Respect Life Month, and the first Sunday of October is designated as Respect Life Sunday.

EVENTS FOR RESPECT LIFE MONTH

- 1. Respect Life Rosary: Parishioners and guests are invited to participate in a Respect Life Rosary each weekend in October per the following schedule.
 - Saturday, October 4th, beginning at 5:15 p.m. inside the church before Mass.
 - Sunday, October 12th, after the 11 a.m. Mass along the fence at the entrance to the church.
 - Sunday, October 19th, after the 8:30 a.m. Mass in the garden by the Our Lady of Guadalupe Statue.
 - Saturday, October 25th, after the 4 p.m. Mass along the fence at the entrance to the church.

NOTE: In case of inclement weather, praying the rosary will be inside the church.

2. Respect Life Month Novena. October 22 – 30, 2025. This novena prays for the protection of human life, from conception to natural death. Each day of the novena features a different pro-life prayer intention which is accompanied by a short reflection and suggested actions to help build a culture of life.
