Prior to dinner, we enjoy a talk by Ian Hutton at the **Museum** followed by dinner at the **Coral Café**. We'll find Ian's talk most interesting!

RAMBLE WALKING TOUR

This morning we join Peter on a relaxed, escorted 3km environmental history **ramble** passing through lovely forests, a mutton-bird rookery, see cliff top views, giant banyans, the valley of shadows, the clear place and **Balls Pyramid**. We start from the much younger land forms where most of the islands residents live and roam into more ancient areas. The reason why Lord Howe is slowly disappearing will be explained and why its sister islands have long gone. This is a great island introduction as we learn about the palm and tourist industry, flora, bush tucker and medicine, birds, volcanic history, snippets of colourful local history and more. Many say the best walking they have ever done. We have the afternoon free for some personal sightseeing, walking or just relaxing. Dinner this evening is at **The Driftwood Restaurant**.

WALKING TOUR TO LITTLE ISLAND

This morning we have some free time to enjoy the island at our own leisure. We can also explore the incredible underwater life and relax on the white sand of **Ned's Beach**. After lunch at the Coral Cafe, we join Peter for a walk to **Little Island**. Starting at the fascinating mountainous end of the Island, we begin a 1km level stroll to the base of the mountains. Here, we see Little Island and where the lagoon's reef comes to its southern end. Rock was obtained from here for the building of the airstrip and it is the start to the **Mt Gower walk**, where Woodhens are often seen. After a rest to enjoy the views and a photo or two, we stroll back. What better way to enjoy an afternoon with a nice walk, food and company. Before dinner at the beautiful **Anchorage Restaurant**, we are treated to a **historical film** in the local hall.

DAY 5

Thursday 23rd April, 2026

CORAL VIEWING

We have our first opportunity to view the pristine beauty of one of the world's untouched reef systems. Learn about this unique marine environment and discover a new world on our **glass bottom boat**. This tour focuses on exploring the coral seascape and introduces visitors to some of the more unusual lagoon inhabitants such as the endemic double-header wrasse, stingrays and turtles. An optional snorkelling experience at **Erscott's Hole** is available or you can just relax on the boat and view the stunning diversity of this exotic marine location. This tour operates within the sheltered waters of the lagoon according to weather, viewing conditions and tide. Back on dry land, there's more free time for personal sightseeing or to settle back with a good book. Dinner this evening is at **The Bowling Club**.

NORTH BAY TURTLE & NATURE TOUR & LORD HOW E ISLAND CRUISE

This morning, view the fish and coral of the world's most southern coral reef as we cruise slowly to the beautiful North Bay. Drift over the wreck of the "Favourite" on our purpose -built glass bottom vessel "Adventure One". While at North Bay the adventurous can snorkel the wreck or take a short climb up Mt Eliza with its panoramic views. View the sea bird rookery (seasonal), swim or just sit and laze the morning away. Our tour includes historical commentary by a 6th generation islander. This afternoon we can view the Island the way it was discovered, from the sea, on our two-hour around the island cruise aboard "Dive Lord Howe". See North Head Cave and cruise along the magnificent volcanic cliffs and spectacular mountain bases. Pass close by the Admiralty Isles with the thousands of sea birds which nest there. The cruise includes commentary from the crew. Tonight we enjoy our farewell dinner at The Anchorage.


DAY 7
