#### CARRARA MARKETS AND TROPICAL FRUIT WORLD

We're lucky enough to be here on a Saturday so this morning, we head to the Carrara Markets, the biggest permanent marketplace in Australia with over 400 market stalls and today we're going to spend some time to explore - it's a treasure trove of the curious and unusual and a bargain hunter's stamping ground! Our next stop is at Tropical Fruit World where after lunch, we are introduced to the home of the largest range of tropical and rare fruit in the world! The plantation is situated on the rim of the largest extinct volcano in the Southern Hemisphere and offers breathtaking views over the Tweed Valley and McPherson Ranges. Travelling by tractor train throughout the orchards, we learn and taste the exotic, unusual and delicious fruit varieties grown on the family farm. This evening we are in for a treat! There is no place on earth like the Australian outback... and no show on earth like the show at the Australian Outback Spectacular -Heartland. Enjoy the story with true Australian characters, Reg and Marge, who are battling a severe five year drought on their farm. Prepare to embark on a vivid, spectacular and emotional ride into the heart of the Australian bush under the iconic red roof with a delicious three course dinner. Australia's favourite dinner and show is more than a night out – it's an experience steeped in courage, tradition and daring Australian spirit. What a fabulous night!

#### THE GOLD COAST

We now have some free time on the famous "Surfers Paradise strip" before returning to the hotel.

#### **EXPLORING THE TWEED**

We're off to Murwillumbah this morning to visit the **Tweed Regional Gallery and Margaret Olley Arts Centre**. Surrounded by beautiful gardens and lawns and offering panoramic views of the Tweed River, the gallery's world class collection of portraits represents Australians from all walks of life. The Centre celebrates the career, life and legacy of its namesake, Margaret Olley — Australia's most celebrated painter of still life and interiors. Next, we are off to gorgeous **Byron Bay** for lunch. Nearby is **Cape Byron** which is Australia's most easterly point. We park the coach and take a look at the **lighthouse precinct** and take a short walk towards the point (A lighthouse tour is NOT included due to the large number of steps involved). Keep an eye out for whales which are often sighted along the coastline. We then meander back up the coast to the hotel with time to relax before dinner.

DAY 5

**Tuesday 8th September, 2026** 

#### DISCOVERING THE HINTERLAND

Today we make our way up Tamborine Mountain, which sits on the edge of the escarpment behind the Gold Coast. Tamborine Mountain is really a collective term for a number of small villages and settlements stretching along the ridge of the mountain range. We enjoy the beautiful views which exist on both sides of the ranges. A great way to experience the rainforest is by strolling along the boardwalk of the Tamborine Rainforest Skywalk so that is our first visit this morning. The walk, which we will do at a leisurely pace, is a unique and thrilling way to explore the rainforest canopies. A short distance from here is our next attraction at **The Cedar Creek Estate**. Our guide welcomes us and takes us on a tour of The Glow Worm Caves. The caves consist of two large chambers interlinked by tunnels. The first chamber is the "presentation cave", where we will be shown an audio-visual display on the glow-worms. This chamber is complete with very realistic formations (speleothems), such as stalagmites and stalactites, water features and flow stone. From this stunning cave, we will be guided through the magical "glow worm cave", filled with thousands of glowing glow-worms! After lunch at the Cedar Creek Estate Restaurant, we will have some free time to wander along Gallery Walk and browse the shops and galleries, before making our way back to the coast and our hotel.

Relish in the opportunity to relax while taking in the abundant nature that the region's river and mangrove system hold, whist enjoying local morning tea and grazing board lunch. We'll enjoy historical commentary from our captain as we uncover the regions history, indigenous culture and world class eco system that forms part of the UNESCO World Heritage Gondwana Subtropical Rainforest.
