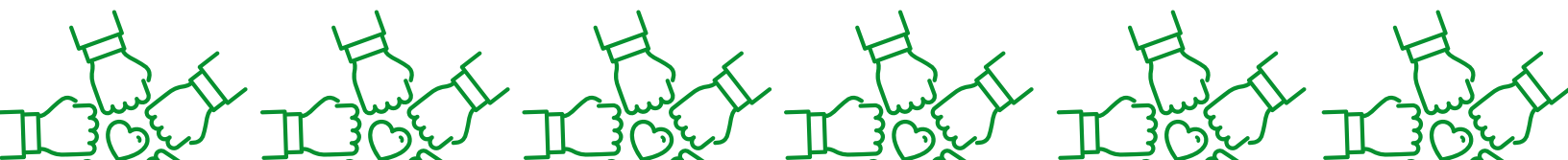
Thank you for your continued partnership and support. Together, we are helping our students grow in both faith and knowledge.

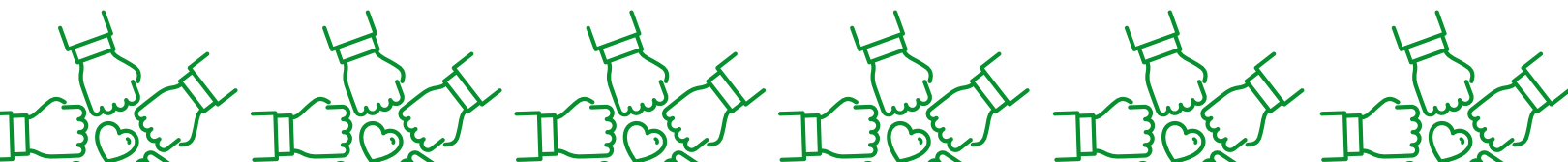

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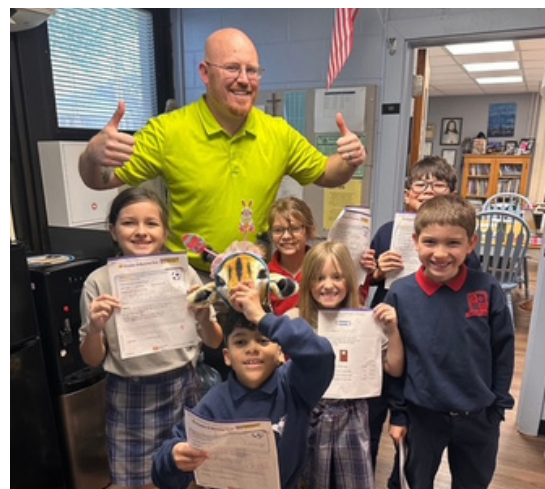
