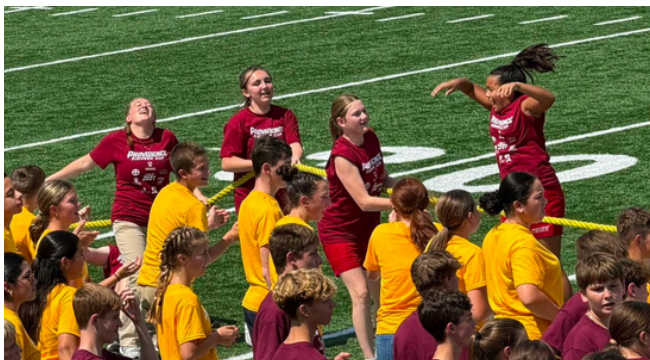
As we continue through the school year, thank you for your continued partnership in supporting our students. Please keep encouraging them to work hard, read each night, and grow in both their faith and their learning.

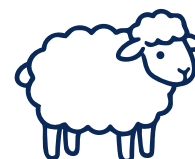
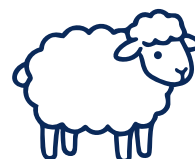
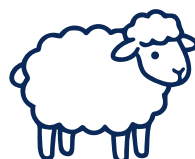
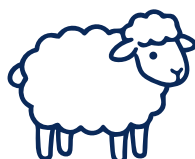
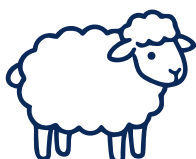
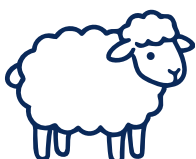
Basketball registration
