Greetings, Sacred Heart Families!

Students are now well into the routine of the school year, and it is wonderful to see them excited about learning and about their faith. Our students gather in Eucharistic Adoration together on Tuesdays, while some of the younger grades go as a class on Wednesday. Parents are welcome to pray in Adoration on Wednesdays in the chapel at Sacred Heart Church. It is available all day every Wednesday.

We did have a lightning strike to our building, most likely during the Tuesday evening storms. It damaged circuit boards in our fire suppression system and our entry door system. The doorbell system is still damaged, so we ask all visitors to the school to call the office at 812-283-3123 to be let in.

Keeping your students home when they are sick and until they are fever- or vomit-free for 24 hours prevents the spread of illness. And your advance notice of taking your student out early allows teachers to have students ready when you arrive.

### **Reminders from the Office**


- SICK POLICY: Students must be free


