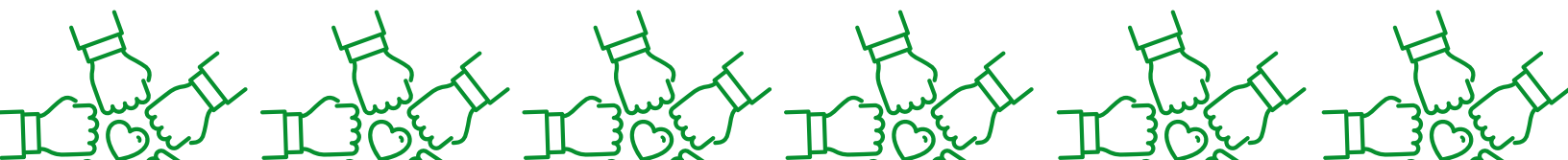

RE-ENROLLMENT FORMS DUE 3/31

Re-enrollment forms for the 2026-2027 school year are due by Tuesday, **March 31**, to reserve **your child's spot for next year**. Many of our classes are full or nearly full. Open enrollment begins April 1.

FINANCIAL AID FORMS DUE END OF MAY

If you are applying for Financial Aid for the 2026-2027 school year, you will need to complete the green form and turn it in along with your 2025 1040 Tax Returns (final copy without watermarks) by the end of May.

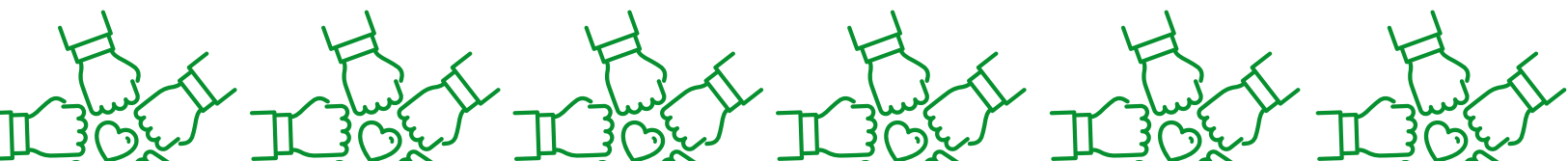
