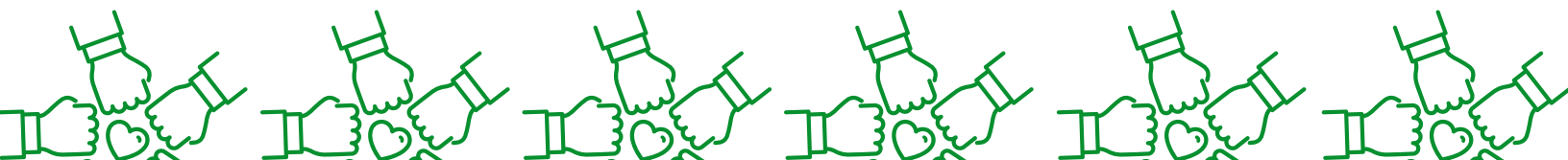

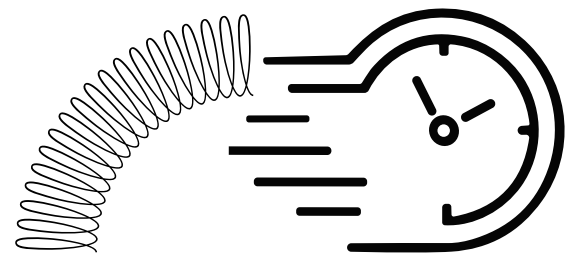

## Deanery Musical auditions March 7

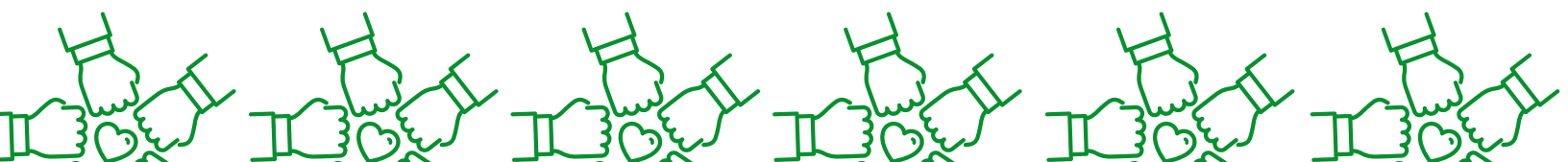
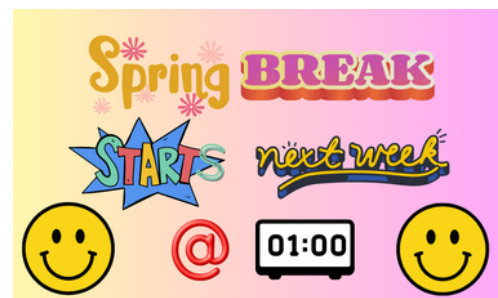

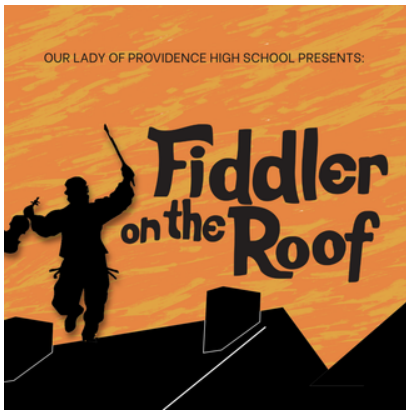


## Tips for the time change
