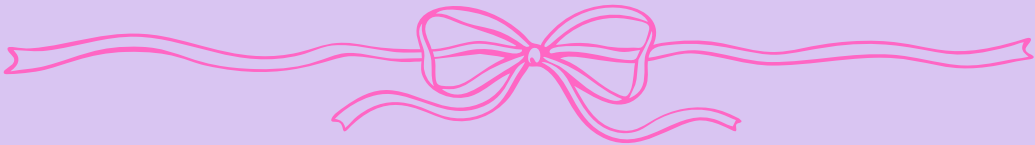

ALL CAMPERS

- Must have a Clean Scalp Exam upon arrival.
- Must be fever free for at least 24 hours.
- Must stay in groups at all times, please never one camper and one leader - always 3 or more.
- Must not leave the campground at any time without permission from the Camp Director.
- Expected to observe habits of personal and group courtesy, cleanliness, and Christian conduct
- No fireworks, tobacco, alcoholic beverages, drugs, or profanity are allowed on the campgrounds.
- No electronic, handheld video games, or cell phones are allowed to be used during the weekend.
- All medications should be registered with Camp First Aid immediately upon arrival. They will be administered under the care of the camp First Aid. All medications must be in the original prescription bottle. (Leaders age 18+ can keep their own medicine as long as it is secure)

General Sisters Together Retreat Policies:

Child Abuse Policy

It is the policy of the Georgia Assemblies of God Camps that cases of suspected child abuse or sexual molestation shall be reported to the Camp Director immediately. It is against the law to keep information concerning abuse and not report it. We are mandatory reporters by law and such information should be communicated immediately.

Fire

Each leader is responsible for evacuating her room with all girls. Campers will move to the lower parking lot in front of the Addison Hall up the hill. Leaders must make sure all campers are accounted for and notify camp staff.

Tornado/Storm

Leaders immediately wake girls, ensure each camper is accounted for and move to the basement of Bray or the basement of the cafeteria, whichever is closest. Move to the most interior part of the building away from windows.

Lightning

Campers should not be outside when there is lightning. Stay away from water areas, windows, plumbing, etc..

Visitor Policy

For safety reasons and the overall flow, visitors are strongly discouraged. Anyone who is not approved, leaders and campers, must be approved by the Camp Director. Any visitors must check in and out in the cafeteria, and should never be in the dorms. Visitors may not check out any student without going through the Camp Director.

Dress Code

Modest clothing must be worn.
