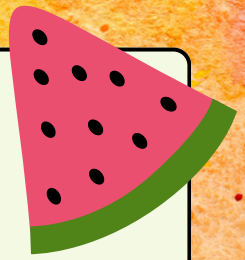

Congratulations to all former Saints graduating from high schools, colleges, and universities this year! We are proud of all of your accomplishments and wish you continued success and blessings in the future.

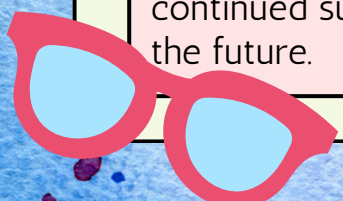
## Final Newsletter for the 2025–2026 School Year
