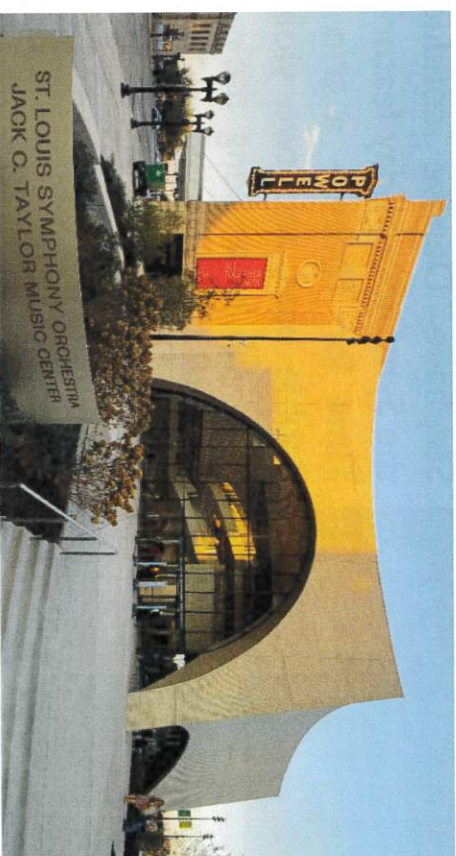

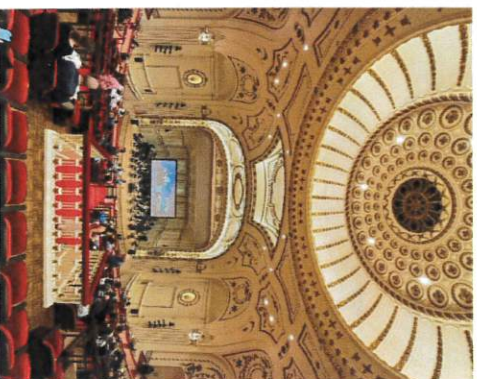


Take your seat and make yourself comfortable for “**A COSMIC JOURNEY.**”
