MAP Test Results

During the week of October 20, St. Ambrose classes (3-8 grade) completed MAP (Measure of Academic Progress) standardized testing. The testing focused on four areas; Language Usage, Reading, Math, and Science. Individual results were shared with parents and if you did not receive results for your student(s), please contact their homeroom teacher. Based on the individual results, our Fall testing appeared to be very successful, but we will have to wait until December when group results are released for a full and detailed comparison.

Playground Upgrades

We are exploring renovating our playground space, including looking at the possibility of installing field turf in the grass field. A list of recommended installers was provided by Dave McClintock, parishioner and Director of Building and Grounds for the Alton School District.

Kim Wackerly - Dean of Curriculum and Instruction

We are so pleased to welcome Kim Wackerly back to our administrative team in an official capacity. Kim will serve as our Dean of Curriculum and Instruction and will continue working with different tasks, including MAP testing, Faith Family activity coordination, Catholic Schools Week, planning, and aiding in curriculum and instruction adjustments.
