Call to Order: Chairperson Erin Kochan opened the meeting at 6:01 p.m.

Approval of September Minutes: A motion to approve the Minutes from the September meeting as previously distributed was made by Mark Terry and seconded by Justin Lacy. The motion was carried with unanimous approval.

Standing Committee Updates:

- Executive Committee (Erin Kochan/Justin Lacy/Ashley Lack): No report.
- Policy/Planning (Justin Lacy): The Council will begin looking at the Athletic Handbook. Bob Baird will send the current handbook to Justin Lacy, who will make an initial review/recommendations and present his change suggestions to the Council at the November meeting.
- Development (Mark Terry): See the attached SAPA report. Dress Down Day Pass sales were approximately \$1800. Applefest did very well; numbers coming soon. Football raffle profit was approximately \$4500. Dine to donate upcoming on October 26 at Bakes and Hale.
- Public Relations (Stephanie Monroe/Bob Baird): There has been positive feedback on the Saints Spotlight videos so far. Father Steve notes that there has been positive feedback on the baby blankets for newly baptized babies in the parish.
- Building/Grounds (Open; Bob Baird/Father Steve reporting): Roof project is mostly
 finished; some finishing touches (gutters, etc) need to be completed. A discussion was
 held regarding the recommendation from the Safety and Security Committee that all
 school Masses are to be held in the gym for the foreseeable future. This change is already
 in effect.

• Athletics (Bob Baird reporting for Bob Baird/Justin Johnson): The 8th grade boys' basketball team will need 6th/7th grade students to play up to have enough students for a team. Cheerleading will be getting uniforms this year. The 8th grade girls' basketball team will be combined with 5th-8th grade students to have enough for a team..

IT Update (Deacon Jay Wackerly): See attached report.

Principal's Update (Bob Baird): A question was asked about St. Ambrose purchasing our own bus for use for field trips and sporting events. Bob Baird notes that he looked into this last year when it was brought up at a SAPA meeting and it was cost prohibitive. We will continue utilizing the Marquette buses when they are available.

Additional Discussion: There was a discussion regarding the success of Applefest and highlights of changes this year, including adult gaming, which were well received.

New Business: Father Steve notes that a new faculty/staff position has been created: Dean of Curriculum and Instruction. Kim Wackerly will now officially have this role as a paid faculty/staff member. She was doing these tasks on a volunteer basis previously. See the attached job description. Father Steve also notes that Alton High Student Wyatt Kohl will have donation boxes in church for the ROTC collection for hygiene products. These donations will be distributed to the homeless through the Salvation Army. Justin Lacy asked if there was still an open Council position, as he has someone who is interested in joining. Erin Kochan encourages this person to apply.

Security Update

The Safety and Security Committee met on Sept. 22 and provided two primary recommendations. The first was to continue school Masses in the gym. The second was to eliminate outdoor recess in the lower parking lot. Both of these recommendations were immediately implemented. The exact details of Grandparents Day are still under consideration and will be shared soon. Additional intruder safety drills were conducted Sept. 24 and 25. From these drills we have improved and updated processes. Following these drills we will regularly remind students of emergency procedures.

During these visits the community was reminded of our Applefest festivities as well as good news from our school.
