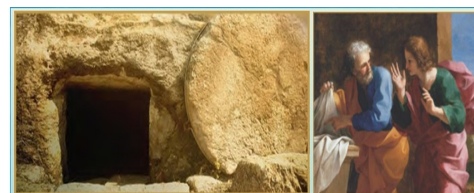
"Did not our hearts burn within us while He talked to us on the road, while He opened to us the scriptures?" [Lk. 24:32]

Third Easter Sunday --

Today, on the third Sunday of Easter, we hear the story of the two disciples who encounter the risen Lord as they walk the road to Emmaus. They listen to this stranger as he opens the scriptures to them, explaining that the Christ had to suffer and die before rising in glory. After inviting him into their home, they recognize him when he breaks bread with them at their table. Every Sunday we live out this experience. We listen to the risen Lord speak to us through God's word. Then we receive him in the Eucharist. May we, like the disciples on the road to Emmaus, invite him into our midst.

Tercer Domingo de Pascua --

Hoy, en este tercer domingo de Pascua, escuchamos el relato de los dos discípulos que se encontraron con el Señor resucitado mientras iban por el camino hacia Emaús. Lo invitan a quedarse con ellos y después, sentados a la mesa, lo reconocen cuando tomó el pan, lo partió y se los dio. Cada domingo nosotros vivimos esa misma experiencia. Escuchamos al Señor resucitado que nos habla mediante la palabra de Dios y entonces lo recibimos en la Eucaristía. Que también nosotros, al igual que los discípulos que iban camino a Emaús, invitemos al Señor a quedarse entre nosotros.
