WHAT IS HOLY WEEK ALL ABOUT? This is the climax of the whole liturgical year. We celebrate solemnly and intentionally the mystery of our salvation, the Paschal Mystery, the suffering, death and resurrection of Christ. It is the New Passover in the New Exodus that leads the New Israel into the New Creation. We are invited to enter this mystery by recalling the story of our salvation recorded in the Bible and participate in the liturgy prepared for us by the Church. May the word of God renew our mind, and the sacraments transform our heart, preparing us for the New Creation brought about by Jesus' resurrection.

SEMANA SANTA -- Este es el clímax de todo el año litúrgico. WHY DO WE COVER CROSSES AND IMAGES?


It is meant to heighten our senses to remind us that Lent is a time of Penance and Preparation, and to build up our anticipation that Easter Sunday is not far away. While it may appear counterintuitive to veil crosses, statues and images during the final weeks of Lent, the Catholic Church recommends this practice to heighten our senses and build within us a longing for Easter Sunday. When we walk into church and notice everything is covered, we immediately know that something is different. The last two weeks of Lent are meant to be a time of immediate preparation for the Sacred Triduum, and these veils are a forceful reminder to get ready.

ADULT CONFIRMATION:

Let us pray for these three women as they receive the Sacrament of Confirmation on Easter Vigil. Protect and guide them in their journey. Strengthen them and grant them the gifts of the Holy Spirit. We ask this through Christ, our Lord.

Easter Triduum



Did you know? The summit of the Liturgical Year is the **Easter Triduum**- from the evening of Holy Thursday to the evening of Easter Sunday. Though chronologically three days, they are liturgically one day unfolding for us the unity of Christ's Paschal Mystery. The single celebration of the Triduum marks the end of the Lenten season and leads to the Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord at the Easter Vigil. The liturgical services that take place during the Triduum are: • **Mass of the Lord's Supper** • **Good Friday of the Lord's Passion** • **Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord**.

¿SABÍAS TU? La cumbre del Año Litúrgico es el **Triduo Pascual**, desde la tarde del Jueves Santo hasta la tarde del Domingo de Resurrección. Aunque cronológicamente son tres días, litúrgicamente son un día que nos revela la unidad del Misterio Pascual de Cristo. La única celebración del Triduo marca el final del tiempo de Cuaresma y conduce a la Misa de la Resurrección del Señor en la Vigilia Pascual. Los servicios litúrgicos que se llevan a cabo durante el Triduo son: • **Misa de la Cena del Señor** • **Viernes Santo de la Pasión del Señor** • **Misa de la Resurrección del Señor**.
