SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Anointing of the Sick: If you are seriously ill, having a major surgery, elderly of the parish, or in danger of death call the priest 979-280-5397.

Baptism: Parents must attend baptismal oriental class before the baptism date. Please contact the church office.

Quinceañera: Parents must be registered members. The girl must be attending faith formation classes, and have received Baptism, First Communion, penance and be enrolled in Confirmation class. A required retreat consisting of 4 weekends. Please contact the parish priest 6 months in advance.

Marriage: Couple must contact the parish priest at least SIX months to a year before the wedding. Preparation classes are required. Please contact the parish priest.

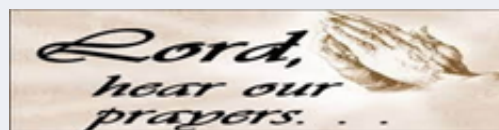

HOLY TRINITY SUNDAY

The Catechism teaches that “by sending his only Son and the Spirit of Love in the fullness of time, God has revealed his innermost secret: God himself is an eternal exchange of love, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, and he has destined us to share in that exchange”(221). By pondering the truth of the Trinity, we also realize the full truth of ourselves. By his gift of faith, God has made his own life available to us even now. “The complete Trinity dwells in us” (Fr. Marie Michel Phhilson, o.p.) God reveals the fullness of his very self to us that we “might not perish but might have eternal life,” and that we might be received as his own.

Domingo de la Santísima Trinidad

El Catecismo enseña que “al enviar a su Hijo único y al Espíritu de Amor en la plenitud de los tiempos, Dios ha revelado su secreto más íntimo: Dios mismo es un eterno intercambio de amor, Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo, y nos ha destinado a participar en ese intercambio” (221). “Las tres personas son una sola Verdad” (San Agustín). Al meditar en la verdad de la Trinidad, nos percatamos también de la plena verdad sobre nosotros mismos: mediante su don de la fe, Dios ha puesto su propia vida a nuestra disposición, incluso desde ahora. “La Trinidad entera habita en nosotros” (Padre Marie-Michel Philipon, O.P.) Dios nos revela la plenitud de su propio ser para que “no perezamos, sino que tengamos vida eterna”, y para que seamos acogidos como suyos.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR SACRAMENT PREPARATION:

Please provide the following documentation by August 12, 2026

- Baptism (for students not baptized yet, ages 7 & older)- Birth Certificate
- First Holy Communion: Baptism Certificate
- Confirmation: Baptism & First Holy Communion Certificate

NOTE: All students & their parents who are receiving First Communion & Confirmation are required to attend Sunday Masses.
