Los certificados estarán disponibles para aniversarios en incrementos de cada cinco años [por ejemplo, 10, 15, 20, 25, etc.]. Los certificados se entregarán el fin de semana del Día Mundial del Matrimonio [14 y 15 de febrero]. Second Sunday in Ordinary Time – Ever since Christmas we have heard how Jesus was revealed over time to the wider world. He was made manifest to the nearby shepherds on the night of his birth. The Magi followed the star from distant lands to the east. Last week we heard that the Holy Spirit descended like a dove, revealing Jesus at his baptism. Today we hear John the Baptist see Jesus and testify, “Behold the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world.” We say the same words at each Eucharist. May they resonate with us today and always.



The Sundays and weeks of Ordinary Time, on the other hand, take us through the life of Christ. This is the time of conversion. This is living the life of Christ.

Ordinary Time is a time for growth and maturation, a time in which the mystery of Christ is called to penetrate ever more deeply into history until all things are finally caught up in Christ. The goal, toward which all of history is directed, is represented by the final Sunday in Ordinary Time, the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe
