SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Anointing of the Sick: If you are seriously ill, having a major surgery, elderly of the parish, or in danger of death call the priest 979-280-5397.

Baptism: Parents must attend baptismal class before the baptism date. Please contact the church office.

Quinceañera: Parents must be registered members. The girl must be attending faith formation classes, and have received Baptism, First Communion, penance and be enrolled in Confirmation class. A required retreat consisting of 4 weekends. Please contact the parish priest 6 months in advance.

Marriage: Couple must contact the parish priest at least SIX months to a year before the wedding. Preparation classes are required. Please contact the parish priest.

INFORMACION SACRAMENTAL

UNCIÓN DE LOS ENFERMOS: si está gravemente enfermo, tendrá Una cirugía mayor, los ancianos de la Parroquia, o en peligro de muerte, llame al Sacerdote. El Sacramento de la Unción de los Enfermos también está disponible según sea necesario, porfavor llame a la Oficina Parroquial para programar.

BAUTISMO: Los padres tienen que estar registrados como miembros de la parroquia y tienen que asistir a una clase de orientación antes del bautismo. Para obtener más información, favor de llamar a la oficina de la parroquia.

QUINCEAÑERAS: Los padres de la joven deben de ser miembros registrados de la parroquia. La joven debe estar atendiendo las clases de Formación de Fe y haber recibido los sacramentos de bautismo, primera comunión, penitencia y estar inscritas en la clase de la Confirmación. Los padres deben contactar a la parroquia de seis [6] meses a un año antes de agendar la celebración la Quinceañera.

MATRIMONIO: La pareja debe hablar con el sacerdote SEIS MESES a unañ de anterioridad a la boda. Clases de preparación son requeridas. Favor de llamar a la oficina par hacer una cita con el sacerdote.

REQUIREMENTS OF STUDENTS

A. Children who attended Faith Formation classes at St. Mary's Hearne last year & want to attend this year must register AGAIN. If your child attended Faith Formation at another parish, you must bring a signed letter from that parish on the day of registration.

B. Be members of St. Mary's Hearne.

1. The family must be registered & active members since January 2026 or earlier. It is recommended that you use your envelopes to demonstrate that you are an active member.

Please present your membership paper when registering your children. To verify church membership, you should bring an offering envelope & the number or stop by the parish office to obtain.

2. If you are not registered at St. Mary's Hearne but regularly attend Mass at our parish, then you will only be enrolled when you register your students & indicate that you will register at St. Mary's Hearne. In addition, you must request a letter of permission from the parish that you used to belong to. In which they authorize your child to receive sacramental preparations.

- We are excited to begin preparing for another wonderful year of Faith Formation! Having families register early helps us plan for the year ahead, including determining how many classes we will need and recruiting the right number of teachers and volunteers to serve our students well.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR SACRAMENT PREPARATION:

If your child is preparing to receive a sacrament during the 2026-27 Faith Formation Year, you will need to provide the following documentation by August 12, 2026, so your child will be placed in the correct sacramental preparation class.

- Baptism (for students not baptized yet, ages 7 & older)- Birth Certificate
- First Holy Communion: Baptism Certificate
- Confirmation: Baptism & First Holy Communion Certificate

NOTE: Documents can be dropped off at the parish office. All students and their parents who are receiving First Communion & Confirmation are required to attend Sunday Masses.

Si su hijo se está preparando para recibir un sacramento durante el año de Formación de Fe 2026-27, deberá proporcionar documentación adicional antes del 12 de agosto de 2026, para que su hijo sea ubicado en la clase de preparación sacramental correcta.

Documentación requerida para estudiantes que se preparan para los siguientes sacramentos:

- Bautismo (para estudiantes aún no bautizados, de 7 años en adelante) – Acta de Nacimiento
- Primera Comunión – Certificado de Bautismo
- Confirmación – Certificados de Bautismo y Primera Comunión

NOTA: Los documentos se pueden dejar en la oficina parroquial. Todos los estudiantes y sus padres que reciben Primera Comunión y Confirmación deben asistir a las Misas dominicales.
