

NOTE: Starting this school year, 2025-2026, we will start a new policy. When you enroll your child, we will require that you are a registered member of St. Mary’s Church. If not, then you need to register your family to St. Mary’s Church. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

If your child is preparing to receive a sacrament during the 2025-26 Faith Formation Year, you will need to provide the following documentation by August 15, 2025, so your child will be placed in the correct sacramental preparation class. Documentation required for students preparing for the following sacraments:

- Baptism (for students not baptized yet, ages 7 and older): Birth Certificate
- First Holy Communion: Baptism Certificate
- Confirmation: Baptism and First Holy Communion

Certificates. Documents can be dropped off at the parish office. All students and their parents who are receiving First Communion & Confirmation are required to attend Sunday Masses. Our classes from Pre-K through 9th grade will be held on Wednesdays; 6:00-7:00 PM

NOTA: Los documentos se pueden dejar en la oficina parroquial. Todos los estudiantes y sus padres que reciben Primera Comunión y Confirmación deben asistir a las Misas dominicales. Nuestras clases desde Pre-K hasta 9th grado se llevarán a cabo los miércoles; 6:00-7:00 PM.
