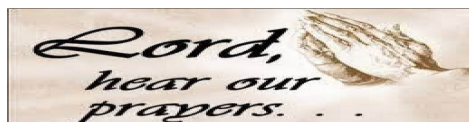

Sexto Domingo de Pascua --

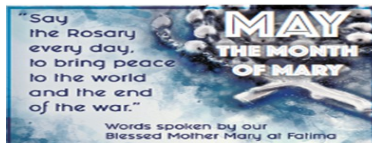
