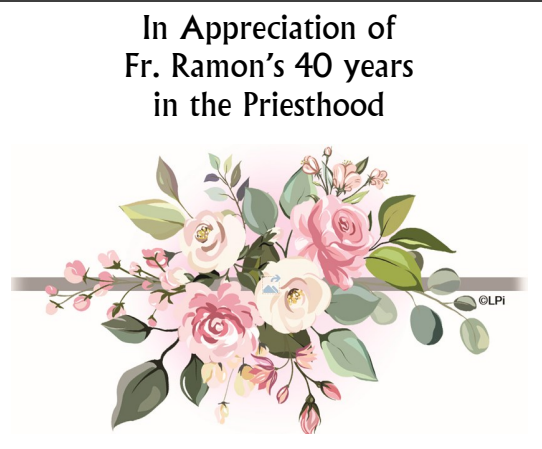
Quinto Domingo de Pascua --

[Easter is a feast that lasts for 50 days, from the Resurrection of the Lord to Pentecost.]

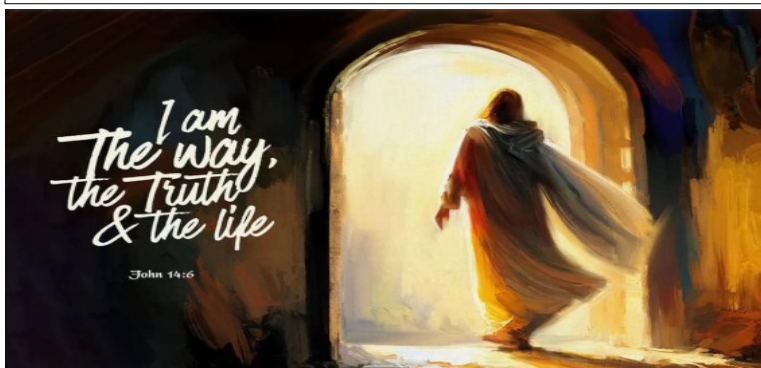
