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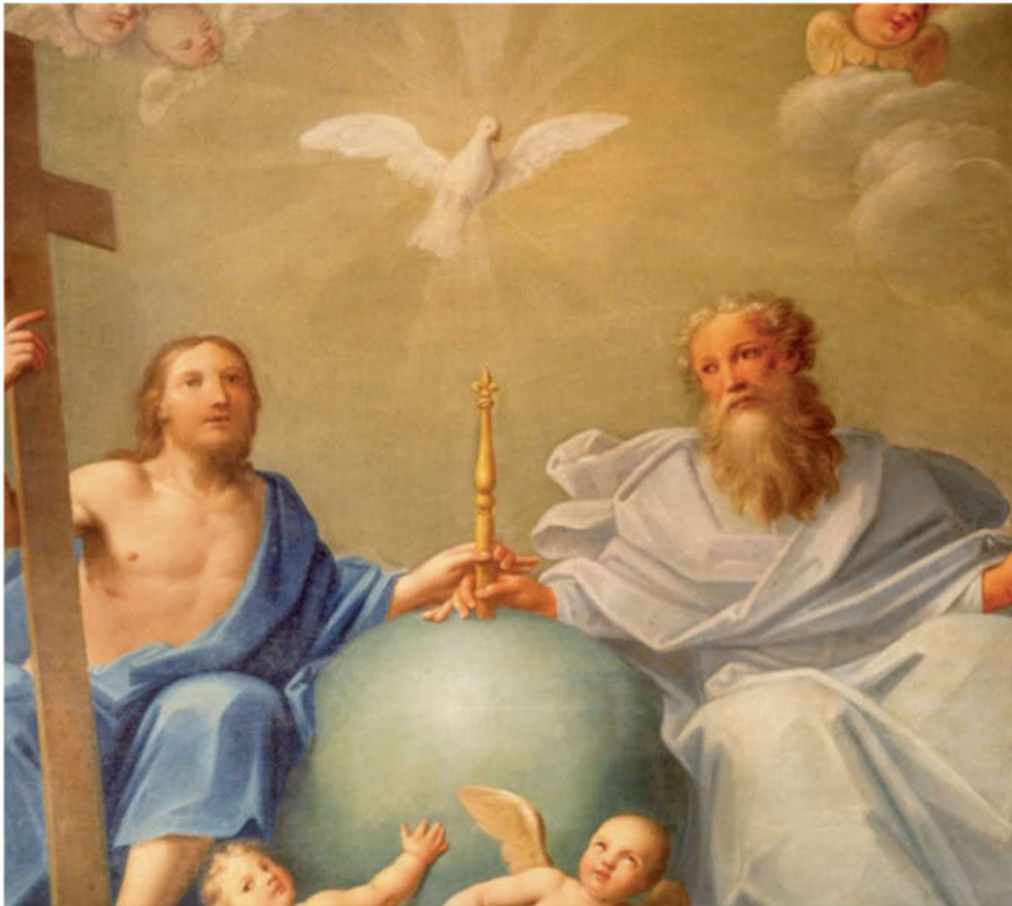

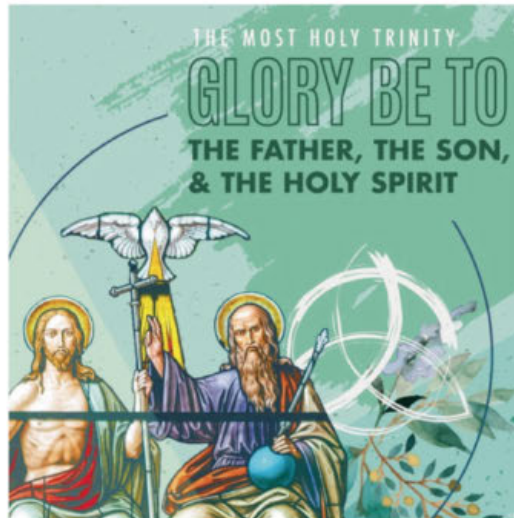

LITURGICAL FOCUS

Holy Trinity Sunday

On the first Sunday after Pentecost the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. This revealed doctrine of God's nature is that the eternal God is one in essence and being, yet three distinct persons—God the Father, God the Son (the Incarnate Jesus Christ), and God the Holy Spirit. This is the central and greatest mystery of the Christian faith. An everlasting and loving union with the Holy Trinity is the final end for which mankind is created. The divine inner life of the Holy Trinity is generously given to us as sanctifying grace through the Church's Sacraments, which is fully and perfectly possessed by the saints in heaven.



ENFOQUE LITÚRGICO

Domingo de la Santísima Trinidad

El primer domingo después de Pentecostés, la Iglesia celebra la Solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad. Esta doctrina revelada sobre la naturaleza de Dios establece que el Dios eterno es uno en esencia y ser, pero tres personas distintas: Dios Padre, Dios Hijo (Jesucristo encarnado) y Dios Espíritu Santo. Este es el misterio central y más grande de la fe cristiana. La unión eterna y amorosa con la Santísima Trinidad es el fin último para el cual fue creada la humanidad. La vida divina interior de la Santísima Trinidad nos es dada generosamente como gracia santificante a través de los sacramentos de la Iglesia, la cual es poseída plena y perfectamente por los santos en el cielo.

THE SACRAMENTS

The definition of the Sacraments according to the Catechism of the Catholic Church is "The sacraments are efficacious signs of grace, instituted by Christ and entrusted to the Church by which divine life is dispensed to us. The visible rites by which the sacraments are celebrated signify and make present the graces proper to each sacrament. They bear fruit in those who receive them with the required dispositions" (n 1131)

The sacraments help to sanctify people and to build up the body of Christ. They are a way for us to relate to God throughout life transitions and help us praise and worship him. They help us nurture, strengthen, and express our faith. Through the sacraments, Jesus remains with His people, strengthening, healing, nurturing, and forgiving them as they face life's challenges.

The Catholic Church celebrates seven sacraments (Baptism, Penance, Eucharist, Confirmation, Marriage, Holy Orders and Anointing of the Sick), which were instituted by Christ during his ministry and which continue to define the liturgical life of the Church today. The Sacraments nourish, strengthen and express faith.

The seven sacraments correspond to all the stages and all the important moments of the Christian's life: they give birth and growth, healing and mission to the life of faith of Christians, they form in which the Eucharist occupies the centre, since it contains the Author of the sacraments himself.

The Religious Education office offers formation classes to receive the sacraments of Penance (confession), Eucharist (first communion), and Confirmation. For more information, contact (760) 745-1611 ext. 806

The Oaxaca Education Fund

The Oaxaca Education Fund (OEF) was founded in 2012 by parishioners of Our Lady of Mount Carmel in Rancho Peñasquitos to support the education of children in the Sierra Mixteca region of Oaxaca, Mexico. The parish has served local migrant farmworkers since 1985, and OEF now helps their children and grandchildren in five villages. OEF provides:

- School supplies to 1,500 children
- Partial university scholarships to 18 students
- Monthly food stipends to 50 orphans and disabled children

So far, 25 students have graduated—many becoming nurses, engineers, teachers, and more. Over half of current scholarship recipients are children of farmworkers once helped by the parish.

While OLMC raises most of OEF's \$65,000 annual budget, additional donations are needed. Your support helps break the cycle of poverty through education and empowers youth to build a future in their own communities.

LOS SACRAMENTOS

El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica ofrece una definición de los sacramentos: «Los sacramentos son signos eficaces de la gracia, instituidos por Cristo y confiados a la Iglesia por los cuales nos es dispensada la vida divina. Los ritos visibles bajo los cuales los sacramentos son celebrados significan y realizan las gracias propias de cada sacramento. Dan fruto en quienes los reciben con las disposiciones requeridas» (n 1131).

Los sacramentos ayudan a santificar a las personas y a edificar el cuerpo de Cristo. Son una forma de relacionarnos con Dios a lo largo de las transiciones de la vida y nos ayudan a alabar y adorar a Dios. Nos ayudan a nutrir, fortalecer y expresar nuestra fe. A través de los sacramentos, Jesús permanece con Su pueblo, fortaleciéndolos, sanándolos, alimentándolos y perdonándolos mientras enfrentan los desafíos de la vida.

La Iglesia Católica celebra siete Sacramentos, Bautismo, Penitencia, Eucaristía, Confirmación, Matrimonio, Orden Sacerdotal y Unción de los enfermos que fueron instituidos por Cristo durante su ministerio terrenal y que continúan definiendo la vida litúrgica de la Iglesia hoy. Los Sacramentos nutren, fortalecen y expresan la fe.

Los siete sacramentos corresponden a todas las etapas y a todos los momentos importantes de la vida del cristiano: dan nacimiento y crecimiento, curación y misión a la vida de fe de los cristianos. Forman un conjunto ordenado, en el que la Eucaristía ocupa el centro, pues contiene al Autor mismo de los sacramentos.

El Fondo de Educación de Oaxaca

Fundado en 2012 por miembros de la parroquia Nuestra Señora del Carmen en Rancho Peñasquitos, el OEF apoya la educación de niños y jóvenes en la Sierra Mixteca, Oaxaca, México, para ayudarles a superar la pobreza. La parroquia ha acompañado a migrantes del campo desde 1985, y ahora apoya a sus hijos y nietos en cinco pueblos de la región. El OEF ofrece:

- Útiles escolares para 1,500 niños
- Becas parciales para 18 universitarios
- Estipendios de comida para 50 niños huérfanos o con discapacidad

Más de la mitad de los becarios actuales son hijos de migrantes atendidos por la parroquia. Ya 25 jóvenes se han graduado como enfermeras, ingenieros, maestros, psicólogos, y más.

Con un presupuesto anual de \$65,000, OLMC contribuye a través de donaciones, campañas y una caminata anual, pero necesitamos más apoyo. Su donación ayuda a transformar vidas a través de la educación y permite a los jóvenes contribuir a sus comunidades.
