GOSPEL REFLECTION

Today, we celebrate the feast of Saints Peter and Paul. They collaborated for the building of the Kingdom of God. They bore witness to the Gospel with their own lives. We all know that, during the hours of the Passion, Saint Peter denied Christ. Saint Paul, for his part, before being called to be an apostle, was a persecutor of Christians. Peter repented and became the first Pope, and died a martyr. Paul, converted to Christianity, was a faithful follower and propagator of the Gospel particulates to the Gentiles and was also a martyr. In what ways do you imitate these great followers of Jesus Christ?

The history of these apostles was not easy; they faced many difficulties. However, they are the foundation of our Church. Each one of them was unique and allowed themselves to be touched by Jesus. We pray today to be firm rocks in our faith, and walk with hope despite the difficulties, knowing that Jesus is with us.

REFLEXIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

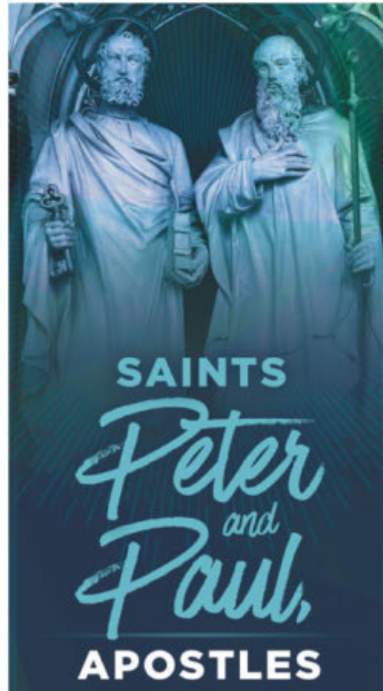
Hoy celebramos la fiesta de los Santos Pedro y Pablo. Ellos colaboraron en la construcción del Reino de Dios. Dieron testimonio del Evangelio con sus propias vidas. Todos sabemos que, durante las horas de la Pasión, San Pedro negó a Cristo. San Pablo, por su parte, antes de ser llamado a ser apóstol, fue perseguidor de Cristianos. Pedro se arrepintió, se convirtió en el primer Papa y murió mártir. Pablo, convertido al Cristianismo, fue un fiel seguidor y propagador del Evangelio entre los Gentiles, y también fue mártir. ¿De qué maneras imitas a estos grandes seguidores de Jesucristo?

La historia de estos apóstoles no fue fácil; enfrentaron muchas dificultades. Sin embargo, son el fundamento de nuestra Iglesia. Cada uno de ellos fue único y se dejó tocar por Jesús. Oramos hoy para que seamos rocas firmes en nuestra fe y caminemos con esperanza a pesar de las dificultades, sabiendo que Jesús está con nosotros.

LITURGICAL FOCUS

Saints Peter & Paul, Apostles

St. Peter and St. Paul (1st C.) were the chief Apostles of Jesus Christ and founders of the Church in Rome. Peter, leader of the Twelve, and Paul, a convert after Christ's ascension, spread the Gospel through their preaching, ministry, and martyrdom in Rome. Under God's guidance, they transformed the Roman capital into the heart of the Church. Peter was crucified upside down on the Vatican hill; Paul was beheaded on the via Ostia. Their burial sites are now marked by St. Peter's Basilica and St. Paul Outside the Walls. As patron saints of Rome, they are honored together on June 29, a feast celebrated since the early Church.



ENFOQUE LITÚRGICO

Santos Pedro y Pablo, Apóstoles

San Pedro y San Pablo (siglo I) fueron los principales apóstoles de Jesucristo y fundadores de la Iglesia en Roma. Pedro, líder de los Doce, y Pablo, convertido tras la ascensión de Cristo, difundieron el Evangelio mediante su predicación, ministerio y martirio en Roma. Guiados por Dios, transformaron la capital Romana en el corazón de la Iglesia. Pedro fue crucificado boca abajo en la colina del Vaticano; Pablo fue decapitado en la Vía Ostia. Sus lugares de sepultura están ahora marcados por la Basílica de San Pedro y la Basílica de San Pablo Extramuros. Como santos patronos de Roma, se les honra juntos el 29 de junio, una festividad que se celebra desde los inicios de la Iglesia.

IT'S REGISTRATION TIME

The Sacraments of First Communion and confirmation complete the process of Christian initiation, which began at baptism. If you are interested in your child receiving the sacraments of First Communion or confirmation, please follow the correct process for your child's age. Children are accepted from the first grade of school for First Communion and 13-year-olds can apply for confirmation. Each sacrament requires at least two years of preparation.

We also offer the preparation of adults for full initiation into the Catholic Church (OCIA/RCIA).

Registration is open from 4:00 pm to 8:00 pm Monday through Friday ending August 30, 2025.

A donation of \$100.00 is required at the time of registration. Classes begin on September 3, 2025.

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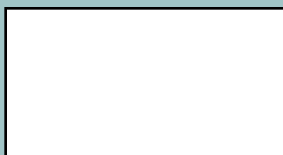


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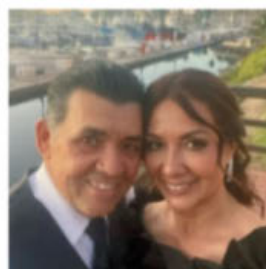
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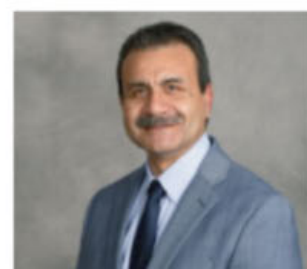
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
