GOSPEL READING

"Be sure of this: if the master of the house had known the hour when the thief was coming, he would not have let his house be broken into. You also must be prepared, for at an hour you do not expect, the Son of Man will come." - Lk 12:39-40

GOSPEL REFLECTION

This passage is a powerful reminder of the unpredictability of Christ's return and the importance of spiritual vigilance. The imagery of a thief in the night evokes a sense of urgency, not fear, but alertness. Jesus urges His followers to live each day as though His return could be at any moment. It speaks directly to the human tendency to grow complacent. When life feels routine or secure, we can slip into spiritual laziness, postponing repentance, kindness, or deeper devotion for another day.

Jesus isn't trying to scare us; He's inviting us to live prepared. Not by hoarding fear, but by cultivating habits of love, service, and trust in God. Being "ready" means living in alignment with His teachings—not just when it's convenient or expected, but always.

REFLEXIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

Este pasaje es un poderoso recordatorio de la imprevisibilidad del regreso de Cristo y la importancia de la vigilancia espiritual. La imagen de un ladrón en la noche evoca una sensación de urgencia, no de miedo, sino de alerta. Jesús insta a sus seguidores a vivir cada día como si su regreso pudiera ocurrir en cualquier momento.

Esto habla directamente de la tendencia humana a la complacencia. Cuando la vida se siente rutinaria o segura, podemos caer en la pereza espiritual, posponiendo el arrepentimiento, la bondad o una devoción más profunda para otro día.

Jesús no intenta asustarnos; nos invita a vivir preparados. No acumulando miedo, sino cultivando hábitos de amor, servicio y confianza en Dios. Estar "listos" significa vivir en sintonía con sus enseñanzas, no solo cuando es conveniente o esperado, sino siempre.

LITURGICAL FOCUS

Solemnity of the Assumption
of the Blessed Virgin Mary

August 15th is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, a Holy Day of Obligation. Celebrated since at least the 6th century, this feast honors the tradition that Mary was taken body and soul into heaven at the end of her earthly life—a moment also known as the Dormition of Mary. The Apostles were said to be present, and her tomb was found empty. This belief, affirmed as dogma by Pope Pius XII in 1950, reflects the Church's teaching that Mary now reigns in heaven with Christ and offers a glimpse of the bodily resurrection promised to all believers.



ENFOQUE LITÚRGICO

Solemnidad de la Asunción de la
Santísima Virgen María

El 15 de agosto es la Solemnidad de la Asunción de la Santísima Virgen María, día de precepto. Celebrada desde al menos el siglo VI, esta festividad honra la tradición de que María fue llevada en cuerpo y alma al cielo al final de su vida terrenal, un momento también conocido como la Dormición de María. Se decía que los Apóstoles estaban presentes y que su tumba se encontró vacía. Esta creencia, afirmada como dogma por el Papa Pío XII en 1950, refleja la enseñanza de la Iglesia de que María ahora reina en el cielo con Cristo y ofrece un atisbo de la resurrección corporal prometida a todos los creyentes.

IT'S REGISTRATION TIME

The Sacraments of First Communion and confirmation complete the process of Christian initiation, which began at baptism. If you are interested in your child receiving the sacraments of First Communion or confirmation, please follow the correct process for your child's age. Children are accepted from the first grade of school for First Communion and 13-year-olds can apply for confirmation. Each sacrament requires at least two years of preparation.

We also offer the preparation of adults for full initiation into the Catholic Church (OCIA/RICA).

Registration is open from 4:00 pm to 8:00 pm Monday through Friday ending August 30, 2025.

A donation of \$100.00 is required at the time of registration. Classes begin on September 3, 2025.

With the help of the Holy Spirit, we all cooperate in the Christian formation of our children and young people. Thank you for allowing us to share this faith journey with you and your child.

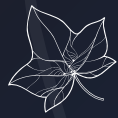

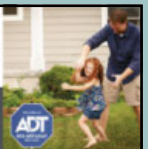
