GOSPEL READING

GOSPEL REFLECTION

The Lord Jesus challenges us in this week's Gospel. He uses the two images of a man building a tower and a king marching soldiers into war to make this single point: acquire what is needed to follow him or look ridiculous. We rightly mock the builder who lacks money for his tower and the king with a short-handed army. But our mocking boomerangs back on us. How do we expect to follow Jesus to the end with insufficient detachment from our possessions and divided hearts?

The good news is, there is still time. Jesus is building a great tower to heaven—his own body. So we renounce all and give ourselves to him as his precious stones. Jesus is waging a battle against our enemy. So we forsake all and swear allegiance and march under his banner.

In this way, we will finish what has begun in our discipleship. Or better put, our Lord will have the stones and soldiers required to see his great work through.

REFLEXIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

El Señor Jesús nos desafía en el Evangelio de esta semana. Usa las imágenes de un hombre que construye una torre y un rey que marcha con soldados a la guerra para enfatizar un solo punto: adquirir lo necesario para seguirlo o quedar en ridículo. Con razón nos burlamos del constructor que no tiene dinero para su torre y del rey con un ejército escaso. Pero nuestras burlas se vuelven en nuestra contra. ¿Cómo esperamos seguir a Jesús hasta el final sin suficiente desapego de nuestras posesiones y con corazones divididos?

La buena noticia es que aún hay tiempo. Jesús está construyendo una gran torre hacia el cielo: su propio cuerpo. Así que renunciamos a todo y nos entregamos a él como sus piedras preciosas. Jesús está librando una batalla contra nuestro enemigo. Así que lo dejamos todo, juramos lealtad y marchamos bajo su estandarte.

De esta manera, terminaremos lo que ha comenzado en nuestro discipulado. O mejor dicho, nuestro Señor tendrá las piedras y los soldados necesarios para llevar a cabo su gran obra.

LITURGICAL FOCUS

Month of Our Lady of Sorrows

The Church dedicates the month of September to Our Lady of Sorrows, also known as Mater Dolorosa (Mother of Sorrows). This devotion recalls the Blessed Virgin Mary's spiritual martyrdom in virtue of her perfect union with the Passion of Christ. This was her role in salvation history, and what merited her place as the spiritual Mother of all Christians. This is symbolized by a single sword, or seven swords, piercing Mary's suffering heart, as foretold in Simeon's prophecy. Traditionally the Church meditates on the "Seven Sorrows" of our Blessed Mother: the prophecy of Simeon; the Holy Family's flight into Egypt; the loss of the Child Jesus for three days; the meeting of Mary and Jesus as he carried his cross; Jesus' crucifixion and death; Jesus' sacred body taken down from the cross; and Jesus' burial. The feast of Our Lady of Sorrows (Mater Dolorosa) is September 15th.

ENFOQUE LITÚRGICO

Mes de Nuestra Señora de los Dolores

La Iglesia dedica el mes de septiembre a Nuestra Señora de los Dolores, también conocida como Mater Dolorosa. Esta devoción recuerda el martirio espiritual de la Santísima Virgen María en virtud de su perfecta unión con la Pasión de Cristo. Este fue su papel en la historia de la salvación y lo que la hizo merecedora de ser la Madre espiritual de todos los cristianos. Esto se simboliza con una sola espada, o siete espadas, que atraviesan el corazón sufriente de María, como se predijo en la profecía de Simeón. Tradicionalmente, la Iglesia medita sobre los "Siete Dolores" de nuestra Santísima Madre: la profecía de Simeón; la huida de la Sagrada Familia a Egipto; la pérdida del Niño Jesús durante tres días; el encuentro de María con Jesús mientras cargaba su cruz; la crucifixión y muerte de Jesús; el cuerpo sagrado de Jesús bajado de la cruz; y el entierro de Jesús. La festividad de Nuestra Señora de los Dolores (Mater Dolorosa) se celebra el 15 de septiembre.

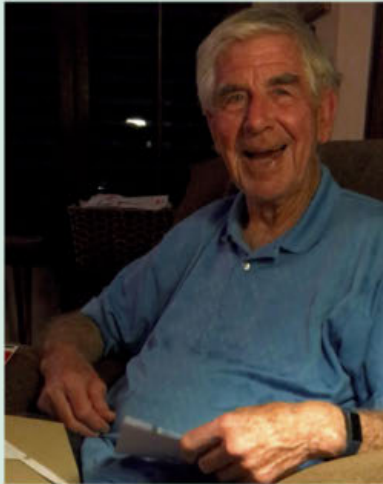
IN LOVING MEMORY OF JOHN MICHAEL COSTELLO, JR.

John Michael Costello, Jr. was born on November 14, 1940, in Washington, D.C., the third of 13 children to John and Anna Costello. As a toddler, his family moved to Riverside County, California, where he was raised. He earned a B.A. in Math from San Diego State University and began his career in computer programming, which led him to Kauai and later to NASA in Houston, where he was honored to contribute to the Apollo 11 mission.

While in Houston, John met his beloved wife, Janie. They later moved to Melbourne, Australia, and then to Chula Vista, California, to be near family. There, they raised two daughters, Caroline and Catherine. In the late 1980s, they settled in Escondido and joined St. Mary Parish. 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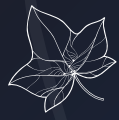
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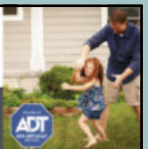
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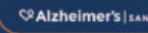
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
