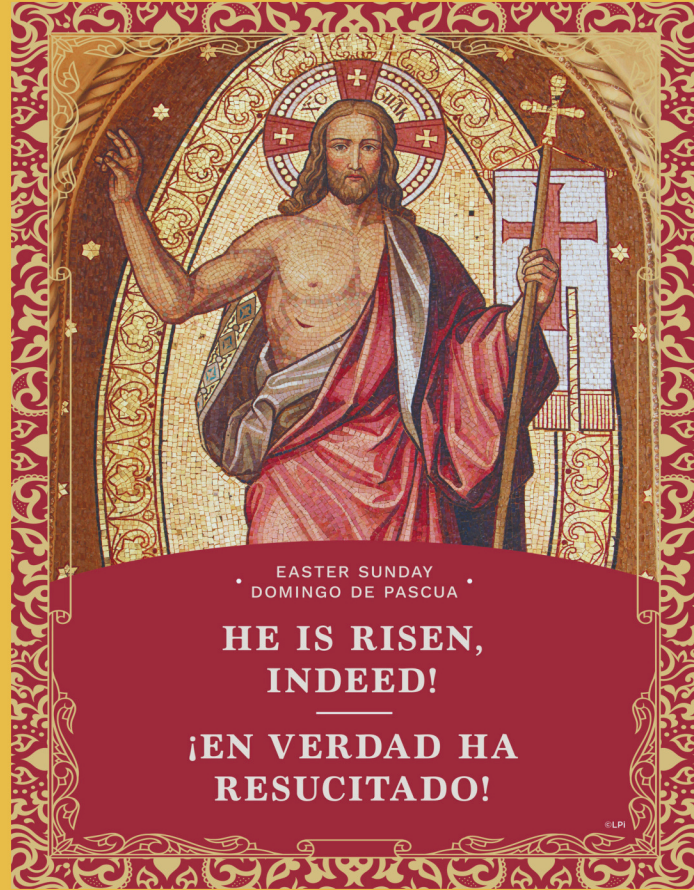

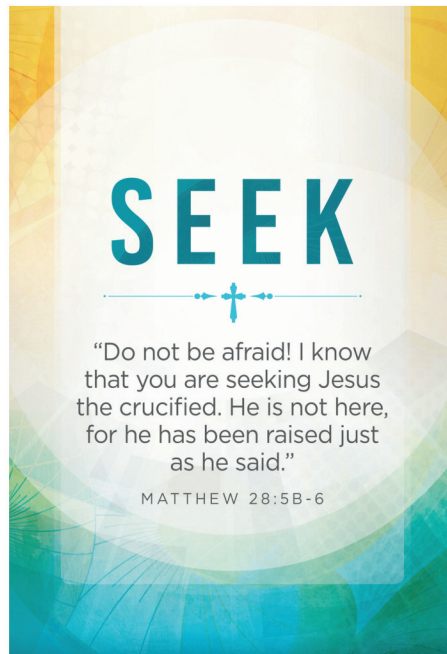

EASTER: THE RESURRECTION OF OUR LORD

On Easter Sunday the Church celebrates the Resurrection of Our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, from the dead, the greatest feast of the liturgical year.

For this purpose Jesus Christ, the Son of God, was sent into the world. Through the celebration of this feast Christians also anticipate the resurrection of their own glorified bodies at the Second Coming of Jesus Christ. It is customary for Christians to joyfully proclaim to one another, "He is risen!" with the response, "He is risen, indeed!"

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION REGISTRATION OPEN

Our Religious Education Program prepares a person for complete initiation into the Catholic Church and a rich and active life in the Church. It encompasses the preparation of those who have been baptized to receive their First Communion and Confirmation. As well as the preparation of adults for full initiation into the Catholic Church (OCIA) The purpose of the Religious Education program is to educate the children in the Catholic faith so that they can assume their responsibilities in today's world.

In addition to instructing your children in Christian truth, we welcome the opportunity to assist you, the parents, in fulfilling your primary obligation to help you teach your children to walk in ways of faith. This can only be done when each family places Jesus Christ and His teachings at the center of their lives through Sunday worship, family prayer and daily living of the Christian message. Regular attendance at Sunday Mass with your children is an essential part of their religious education.

Registration is now open for the next cycle of classes (2026-2027) that will begin in September. Children are accepted from the first grade of school for First Communion and 13-year-olds can apply for confirmation. All sacraments require at least two years of preparation and include parents who share the same class schedule.

LOURDES VIRTUAL PILGRIMAGE EXPERIENCE

St. Mary parishioners on March 21 gathered more than 5000 miles from the Grotto of Massabielle where Our Lady of Lourdes appeared 18 times to a teenaged St. Bernadette Soubirous in 1858. The virtual experience, brought to our parish by the Our Lady of Lourdes Hospitality North American Volunteers headquartered in New York, is a way to spiritually visit one of the most revered Catholic pilgrimage sites in the world, located in Lourdes, France. St. Mary prayer intentions reached Lourdes by Holy Week.

The virtual program allowed pilgrims to participate in the devotion and atmosphere of Lourdes such as touching Lourdes' healing water and a piece of the Grotto rock. Participants also received a Plenary Indulgence by Papal Decree.

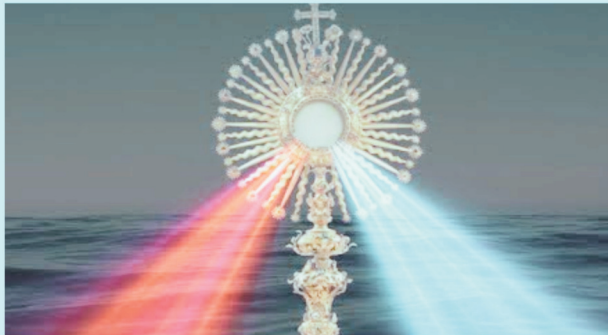

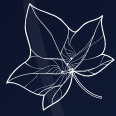

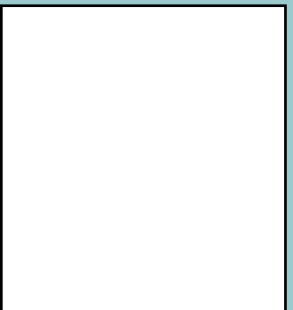
