GOOD SHEPHERD SUNDAY

The Fourth Sunday of Easter is called Good Shepherd Sunday because of John's Gospel when Jesus uses the imagery of a shepherd guiding and guarding his flock to describe His relationship with those He has redeemed.

On this Good Shepherd Sunday, we pause to give thanks for our priests, who reflect the care and compassion of Christ the Good Shepherd in our lives. Through their guidance, sacrifice, and faithful service, they lead, nourish, and support our community in countless seen and unseen ways. Today, we lift them up in prayer with gratitude, asking God to strengthen and bless them.

"The sheep follow him, because they recognize his voice," Jesus says. Do we know the voice of Jesus when he speaks to us? Have we spent time in conversation with him? This week, listen for the voice of Jesus in your life, and follow where it leads.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION IS UPON US

First Communion is one of the seven sacraments of the Church, and one of the three sacraments of initiation to the Christian life along with baptism, and confirmation. Through first communion, it is possible to take for the first time the bread and wine, which for those who profess our faith, is not symbol, but is the Body and Blood of Christ. The real presence of the body and blood of Christ in the bread and wine is what is called Transubstantiation.

First Communion, the reception of the Eucharist for the first time, is a crucial moment in life. As Catholics, we firmly believe that the Eucharist is truly the Body and Blood of Jesus. As such, we provide training to students to help them prepare to receive such a great gift. Finally, we celebrate the sacrament of the Eucharist, emphasizing that it is the beginning of a new Christian life for your children and family. 198 children from the community of St. Mary Church will be receiving First Communion during the month of May. LA PRIMERA COMUNIÓN ESTÁ POR LLEGAR

La Primera Comunión es uno de los siete sacramentos de la Iglesia, y uno de los tres sacramentos de iniciación a la vida cristiana junto al bautismo, y confirmación. A través de la primera comunión, es posible tomar por primera vez el pan y el vino, que para quienes profesan nuestra fe, no es símbolo, sino que es el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo. La presencia real del cuerpo y la sangre de Cristo en el pan y el vino es lo que se denomina Transubstanciación.

La Primera Comunión, la recepción de la Eucaristía por primera vez, es un momento crucial en la vida. Como católicos, creemos firmemente que la Eucaristía es verdaderamente el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Jesús. Como tal, brindamos formación a los estudiantes para ayudarlos a prepararse para recibir un regalo tan grandioso. Finalmente celebramos el sacramento de la Eucaristía, enfatizando que es el comienzo de una nueva vida cristiana para sus hijos y su familia. 198 niños de la comunidad de la iglesia Santa María estarán recibiendo la primera comunión durante el mes de mayo. IN THE NEWS

PRO-LIFE VOLUNTEER ACQUITTED

Pro-life volunteer Mark Houck, a father of seven from Pennsylvania, has reached a seven-figure settlement in his lawsuit against the U.S. Department of Justice. Houck was previously charged under the Freedom of Access to Clinic Entrances (FACE) Act following an incident outside an abortion facility in 2022.

The case drew national attention after federal agents conducted an early morning raid on his home, arresting him in front of his wife and children. In January 2023, a federal jury acquitted Houck of all charges. He later filed a lawsuit citing wrongful prosecution and violations of his constitutional rights, which has now been resolved through this settlement.

Many see this outcome as an affirmation of the right to peacefully pray and offer support outside abortion facilities.

Let us continue to pray for the protection of life, for justice, and for peace in our communities.



EN LAS NOTICIAS

ABSUELTO UN VOLUNTARIO PROVIDA

El voluntario provida Mark Houck, padre de siete hijos y residente de Pensilvania, ha alcanzado un acuerdo extrajudicial de siete cifras en su demanda contra el Departamento de Justicia de los Estados Unidos. Houck había sido acusado anteriormente en virtud de la Ley de Libertad de Acceso a las Entradas de Clínicas (FACE, por sus siglas en inglés), tras un incidente ocurrido en 2022 a las afueras de una clínica de abortos.

El caso captó la atención nacional después de que agentes federales llevaran a cabo una redada en su domicilio a primeras horas de la mañana, deteniéndolo frente a su esposa y sus hijos. En enero de 2023, un jurado federal absolvió a Houck de todos los cargos. Posteriormente, presentó una demanda alegando persecución judicial indebida y violaciones de sus derechos constitucionales, la cual se ha resuelto ahora mediante este acuerdo.

Muchos consideran este desenlace como una reafirmación del derecho a orar pacíficamente y a ofrecer apoyo a las afueras de las clínicas de abortos.

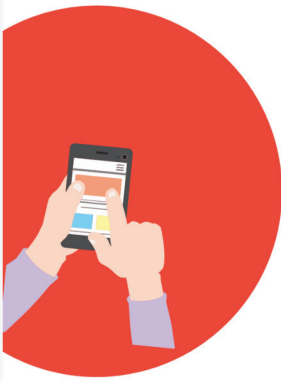

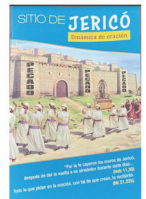

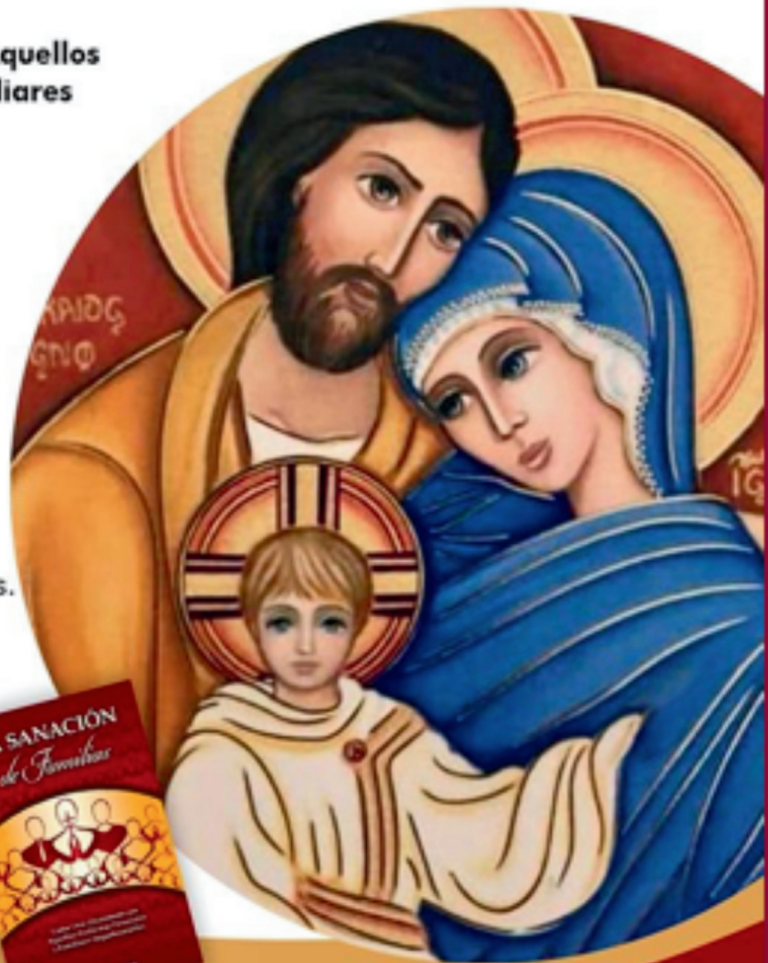
