The objective of the **Churn Churches Climate Action Group** is to encourage conversation and action within the communities served by the Churn Benefice to reduce the impact of Climate Change.

Discussions at the CCCA meeting on the 12th included that many of us are becoming increasingly concerned that the planning authorities responsible for Oxfordshire are building too many expensive houses in the wrong places. This is causing an assault on our countryside and biodiversity, pollution in our rivers, and is not helping our quest towards becoming a carbon net zero society by 2050; and they are not delivering enough homes which are affordable. If you share these concerns, the most helpful thing you can do is to inform our local and national politicians.

You need to tell your representatives what it is that you mind about; personal views are far more important than multiple people saying exactly the same thing. It is important that our county and district councillors are aware of your concerns. Their contact addresses are available on the Council websites. David Johnston, our MP, is already campaigning on these issues and would welcome your support.
