We regularly assess **emergency situations and risks** and take all necessary precautions. We support our region through active involvement in **social responsibility projects**.


We declare our opposition to the **exploitation and harassment of any living creature** and do not condone the hunting or caging of animals.

## Mandatory Rules for Nature Tours in Protected Areas and Other Site Usage

- Organizers wishing to conduct activities in natural areas must obtain permission from the administrative authorities.
- 2. While visiting natural areas, it is strictly forbidden to harm endemic, endangered, or wild species. These species must not be collected or uprooted, and wild animal eggs must not be touched. Entry into restricted access areas is prohibited.
- 3. Visitors must refrain from any activities that could harm birds, and their nests must not be touched.
- 4. Photography and filming are **not allowed in restricted or prohibited areas**.
- 5. Wild animals must **not be startled** and visitors must not approach them closely enough to cause disturbance.
- 6. Any waste generated during visits must not be left in the environment.
- 7. Making excessive noise or playing loud music during tours is prohibited.
- 8. **Lighting fires** in the visitor areas is strictly forbidden.
- 9. Visitors must **stay within the designated areas and routes** during their visits.
- Causing damage to archaeological and cultural artifacts in cultural sites is prohibited.
- 11. Touching or damaging historical monuments is prohibited.
- 12. When visiting mosques and places of worship, visitors must ensure their attire is clean and **compliant with religious regulations**.
- 13. Entering the mosque with dirty feet or socks is prohibited; **footwear must be removed** before entry.
