Scholarship Application Instructions

Our Lady of Lourdes Rosary Altar Society is pleased to offer scholarships to graduating high school seniors who are active members of Our Lady of Lourdes and have been accepted as a full-time student at a trade school, community college, four-year college or university during the 2026-27 academic year as an undergraduate student. Students who have previously applied and did not receive a scholarship may reapply if they are currently enrolled and in good standing in any of the schools noted above.

Applications must be accompanied by a letter of recommendation from a parish ministry leader or staff member. A letter of recommendation from a faculty advisor or employer may also be included, but this is optional.

The application will be deemed incomplete without all necessary entries and will not be considered for the scholarship regardless of need or qualifications.
Please note: Applications **MUST** be signed by the applicant and parent or guardian.

Scholarship recipients will be notified when decisions are final. Awards will be presented at the 10:30 Mass on Sunday, May 17, 2026.

The applicant must be accepted for the fall semester 2026 as a full-time, undergraduate student (minimum of 12 hours/semester) prior to receiving the award.
