Faith Formation 2026-2027 Grades K-Confirmation

SESSION TYPES AND LOCATIONS

Days of the Week/Session Times: Grades K–10 meet on Wednesdays from 6:15–7:30 PM. Confirmation students meet on Sundays following the conclusion of the 10:00 AM Mass and continue until approximately 12:00 PM.

Age-Specific Sessions: Sessions only for children in grades K–1 and 3–7 are facilitated by a catechist. First Sacrament classes (First Reconciliation and First Communion) are facilitated by a catechist, and a parent/grandparent is expected to attend all sessions with their child(ren). Students in grades 8, 9, and 10, as well as Confirmation classes, are facilitated by a catechist/table leader.

Family Sessions: These are sessions in which one parent/grandparent is expected to attend with their child(ren) as a *family*. These dates are noted at the end of the handbook in the age-grouped calendars (i.e., K-7, 8-10, and Confirmation). Please note that some family sessions may differ between K-7 and 8-10.

Mass Sessions: On Ash Wednesday, February 10, 2027, families are expected to attend Mass together; attendance will be recorded. On Wednesday, March 3, 2027, the feast of St. Katharine Drexel, students will attend Mass, and families are encouraged to attend; attendance will again be recorded. These 6:30 P.M. Masses will not exceed the duration of a regular class session.

PARKING LOCATIONS

Parking: Parking is available in the school and church parking lot for grades K–7 families. Parking is available in the Parish Center parking lot for grades 8–Confirmation families.

Drop-off and Pick-up: Grades K–7

DROP-OFF: For all formation sessions, the doors open at 5:45 P.M. Only one door will be open for Faith Formation families — **the Saint Cecilia door**. Families with children in grades K–2

should walk their children to their room locations. Students in grades 3–7 may walk directly to their assigned rooms.

PICK-UP: After all formation sessions, students exit through the inner courtyard (near the playground equipment). Older siblings (grade 8 and up) may pick up their younger siblings from the inner courtyard. To ensure the safety of every child, students are not permitted to enter the parking lot unless accompanied by an adult or older sibling. Additionally, for safety and insurance purposes, children may not use the playground equipment when exiting the building.

Drop-off and Pick-up: Grades 8 – Confirmation

DROP-OFF: For all formation sessions, the doors open at 5:45 PM on Wednesdays for grades 8–10, and after the 10:00 AM Mass on Sundays for Confirmation. Students must use the Parish Center **Office Door**.

PICK-UP: Students exit through the Parish Center Office Door at 7:15 PM on Wednesdays for grades 8–10, and at approximately 12:00 PM on Sundays for Confirmation.

St. Katharine Drexel Faith Formation Program Policies

ENROLLMENT

The Catholic Faith Formation Program of Beaver Dam is available to the children and youth of St. Katharine Drexel Parish. Nonparishioners must seek permission from the pastor of Saint Katharine Drexel Parish to enroll.

FEES

The registration fees for the 2026-2027 school year are as follows:

Grades K through 10..... \$40.00/one student
 \$80.00/two students
 \$120.00/three or more students

Confirmation.....\$100.00/student

There is an additional fee of \$30.00 for those children receiving the sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion.

Flexible payment options are provided by contacting the parish office at 920-887-2082. A family will not be denied faith formation due to an inability to pay tuition.

BEHAVIOR, RULES, AND EXPECTATIONS

- I. Faith Formation sessions are an important part of each child's religious education. In order to maintain a respectful and effective learning environment, students are expected to dress in neat, clean, modest, and appropriate clothing.
- II. Attendance is taken at each class session. If your child is absent, please notify the Faith Formation Office by email at faithformation@stkds.com.
- III. NO CELL PHONE OR SMARTWATCH USAGE DURING CLASS SESSIONS. Students are not permitted to bring smartwatches to sessions. Cell phones may be brought to class only if they are powered off and kept out of sight at all times. Any cell phone that is visible during class will be confiscated and placed in a basket at the front of the room, and a parent or guardian will be required to pick it up after class.
- IV. Personal Behavior: Students are expected to maintain a respectful attitude toward volunteer catechists, fellow students, and themselves. Catechists will handle ordinary classroom discipline with fairness and understanding. However, rudeness, disrespect, offensive language, damage to property, and other inappropriate behavior must be corrected. Students are expected to act in the following ways:
 - a. Participation: When the catechist is speaking, students are expected to listen respectfully and not talk out of turn. If asked to answer a question, students should raise their hand rather than calling out, as shouting answers is distracting for both other students and the catechist.
 - b. Small Group Discussion: At times, students will participate in small group discussions. During these activities, conversation is to remain focused on the topic given by the catechist and should contribute positively to the learning environment.
 - c. Respect for property: All desks, furniture, lockers, smartboards, computers, and other items are the property of St. Katharine Drexel Parish and are not to be tampered with or damaged in any way (e.g., writing on desks or lockers, or turning computers on or off without permission). Students are asked to use the blue recycling bins and gray wastebaskets appropriately. At the end of each session, the classroom space should be put back in order, as it was when students arrived.

- d. Throwing of objects: The throwing or passing of any object during class time is not permitted, particularly if it could cause injury or damage to parish or school property. Students who engage in this behavior will be removed from the classroom immediately.
- e. Students should use the restroom before or after class whenever possible. During class time, students are to remain in their assigned areas unless given permission to leave.
- f. Catechist Rules: Each catechist will establish age-appropriate classroom rules and expectations for their group. Students are expected to follow these expectations as part of maintaining a respectful and orderly learning environment.

Repeated failure to abide by our established Code of Behavior will result in consequences as established below.

The following consequences will be applied for failure to follow the above expectations:

- a) On the first disruption, the student will receive a verbal warning from the catechist.
- b) On the second disruption, the student will meet with the director for a brief conference.
- c) On the third disruption, a conference will be held with the student, the director, and the parent/guardian.
- d) Any further disruptions will result in mandatory parent/guardian attendance with the student in the classroom.

PREPARATION FOR THE RECEPTION OF FIRST RECONCILIATION, FIRST EUCHARIST, OR CONFIRMATION

Children and teens wishing to receive the sacraments of First Reconciliation, First Eucharist, or Confirmation must first complete one full year of faith formation before enrolling in the year of sacramental preparation.

The Office of Religious Education of the Archdiocese of Milwaukee states:

“It is mandatory for parents of children receiving the sacraments of Eucharist and Reconciliation for the first time, or Confirmation, to participate in programs which will be provided by the parish for the purpose of better supporting their children in the participation of the sacrament.”

There will be required classes for parents/guardians before Eucharist and Reconciliation. Please consult the calendar for information as to dates, places, etc. Parents/guardians will be notified by letter of any related information not found in the calendar.

There will be a required parent/sponsor meeting prior to the reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation. This meeting will go over required forms and other paperwork.

All parents/guardians will be notified as to when and where the classes will meet prior to the scheduled times. Children of parents who choose not to attend these classes will be unable to participate in these sacraments at the scheduled time.

Those parents/guardians who feel that they cannot fulfill their responsibility in supporting their children in the sacramental life of a Catholic may be asked to postpone participation of their children in those sacraments until they personally seek counsel with the pastor and are more prepared to guide the development of their child's spiritual life by their own Christian example.

HOMESCHOOLING INFORMATION

Families electing to homeschool their child for faith formation are required to use parish-provided or parish-approved resources. An initial meeting with the Director of Faith Formation and/or Pastor is required before homeschooling begins in order to review expectations and procedures. The parent and child must also be willing to meet twice during the year with the Director of Faith Formation and/or the Pastor to discuss progress and continued participation in the program.

CANCELLATION OF CLASSES

Weather-related cancellations will be announced via the parish website (www.stkatharinedrexelbd.org), email (faithformation@stkds.com), and Smore. If BDUSD schools are canceled due to weather, faith formation classes are canceled. If you are in doubt, please feel free to contact the Parish Center at 920-887-2082.

CURRICULUM

Grades K–7: *Word of Life*

The Word of Life curriculum responds to the 2020 *Directory for Catechesis* and its call to help Christians “give a complete meaning to their existence, educating them in a mentality of faith in keeping with the Gospel” (*Directory*, no. 77). Responding to the needs of contemporary culture and modern man requires an “evangelizing catechesis.” This catechesis centers on an initial proclamation of the gospel message. What makes *Word of Life* unique and impactful is its approach to the “formation of a Christian mentality” (*Directory*, no. 71) and how it creates “a coherent doctrinal vision that can be used as a reference in life” (*Directory*, no. 80).

Grades 8–10: *Catholic Faith Handbook*

Open *The Catholic Faith Handbook, Third Edition* to explore the Catholic faith in engaging, accessible language. Ideal for teens and adults, this newly revised edition fits seamlessly into parish faith formation programs, Confirmation preparation, OCIA, or a Catholic high school curriculum. Full of relatable scenarios and clear explanations of Catholic thought, it’s a resource readers can carry with them as they live out their faith.

Confirmation: *Decision Point*

Decision Point is the first Confirmation program specifically developed to engage young Catholics in a meaningful conversation about the genius of Catholicism. It teaches and inspires teens to respond to God’s grace, and it’s changing hundreds of thousands of young lives.

PRAYER EXPECTATIONS BY GRADE

It is the catechist’s expectation that parents assist their child(ren) in learning and regularly praying the basic prayers of the Catholic faith. For Grades K–7, the foundational prayers to be memorized are:

- The Sign of the Cross
- The Our Father
- The Hail Mary
- The Glory Be

By Grades 3–7, children should also memorize:

- The Apostles’ Creed
- The Act of Contrition (introduced in First Sacrament preparation)
- The St. Michael Prayer

Children should also memorize the Ten Commandments. Middle and high school teens should practice praying with Scripture (for example, through lectio divina or reflective reading of the Gospels). An especially opportune time to reinforce these prayers is during morning and evening family prayer.
