In energy we supported expanded wind farms by Xcel Energy.

In health/human services we met with the Colorado Aging Planning group and will help them promote an event here in Fort Morgan on October 25th. We also participated in a survey for Serve Colorado on the needs in our region. In this area we are also working on a resolution on making sure the medical tax gets delayed another year at the federal level. The policy committee approved moving it to the Board of Directors for ratification.

In Ag we reached out to make sure federal officials were aware of the need in immigration reform to consider agriculture and to work on a resolution that works for everyone on DACA.
