

YOUR BURIAL BENEFITS AS A VETERAN

Veterans may qualify for the following burial benefits based on eligibility at no cost to their family:

Burial Allowance - A designated dollar amount that the VA pays toward a veteran's funeral.

Interment at a National Cemetery - A plot, opening and closing of the grave, and perpetual care for a veteran, the veteran's spouse, and dependents.

Headstone or Grave Marker - A governmentissued headstone or medallion to mark the grave.

Burial Flag with Military Funeral Honors - A flag is provided to drape the casket or urn and given to the next of kin. Military honors includes folding and presenting the United States burial flag and the playing of Taps.

Presidential Memorial Certificate - An engraved certificate, signed by the current President.

Be sure to check with your local Veterans Service Officer to verify your eligibility for these benefits.
