

General Assembly was an amazing, fulfilling, and informative time. I thought I would share some of the highlights with you.

We had amazing preachers: Dr. Bernice King (Yes, MLK's daughter), and Dr. Stephen Cady (President of Brite Divinity School) were especially powerful. I got goosebumps when part of Dr. King's sermon carried the same message I preached as we prepared for Assembly.

The final night, we heard from four past General Ministers and Presidents along side Terri Hord Owens about the past, present, and future of our church. The workshops I attended were great. I am currently trying to figure out how to attend a preaching retreat in the fall that I think would be amazing.

The Exhibit Hall was both dangerous and full of information that I think will be helpful for us in some areas of ministry. I bought two new stoles and came home with a large stack of books to read.

I attended several meals and CCF, who manages our endowment and investment funds, was by far the best. We celebrated generosity!

I'm excited for the implementation process of some new structures for the denomination that we gave the final approval on. We are moving to an in-person General Assembly every 3 years with annual Zoom gatherings.

We will stream these gatherings from the sanctuary so that everyone who wants to can attend. We will have 3 voting representatives for any GA business that comes up at these gatherings. I am currently prayerfully considering who those 3 people might be. If you feel called to be one of them, please let me know.

The next General Assembly will take place in 2028 and the location will be announced at our first Zoom Assembly next July.
