Prayers for Colombia

God, Father of Mercy and Tenderness, You who said to Your people, “Call to me and I will answer you; I will tell you great and unsearchable things you do not know” (Jeremiah 33:3): today we cry out to You, O Lord God, for peace, justice, and reconciliation for Colombia—a country of diverse regions, a country seeking an end to war and the possibility of God’s “shalom” for all. We thank God for the lives of pastors and leaders in the regions who, through their actions, bear witness to hope; who—guided by the Gospel—promote social dialogue in their territories, comfort families affected by the conflict, transform conflicts, and courageously continue participating in local peace dialogues because they feel in their hearts that they are, and will remain, Churches that serve as Sanctuaries of Peace.

Today, during this election season, we join in a collective cry and prayer for Colombia’s future: may sanity and social harmony prevail, and may the longing for peace—grounded in social and environmental justice—become a reality. God of Mercy and Justice, we place ourselves in Your loving hands, and from the depths of our hearts, we lift up our prayers for life—and life in abundance—for “In my distress I called to the Lord; I cried to my God for help. From his temple he heard my voice; my cry came before him, into his ears!” (Psalm 18:6).

Ladies Scrapbooking Group

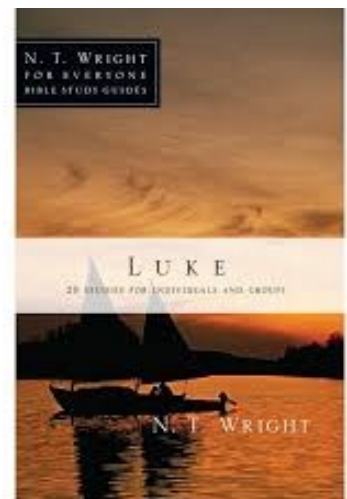
Come join the women to scrapbook, make cards, and other fun craft projects in the Fellowship Hall beginning at 9:00 am.

The Monday Night book group is finishing up the book "I Never Thought of it That Way." And have chosen a new book, "A House Divided." Yes, I know the cover makes it look like a politically charged book. But I assure you it isn't! It explores the question:

How do we find common ground in issues that divide us?

We live in what feels like incredibly divided times, so divided that we shy away from talking with people instead of talking and listening to each other. Until we find ways to bridge the divides, it is hard to see a way forward together.

Our last book was written from a secular perspective and challenged us to look at ourselves, and how we communicate. I hope this book continues the challenge from a religious perspective.

Here is a description of the book. I hope you will join us for good discussions (and hopefully a video component that will add to the discussions). The goal isn't to change anyone's mind. The goal is understanding and connections.

"In our current culture of conflict, Americans need a better way of relating to one another and responding to controversial issues; a way that transcends political partisanship and emphasizes mutual concern, and the flourishing of the common good.

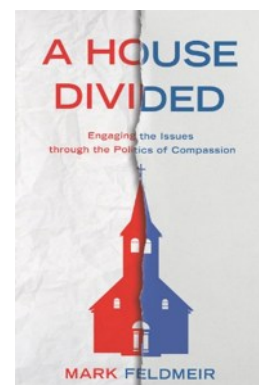
