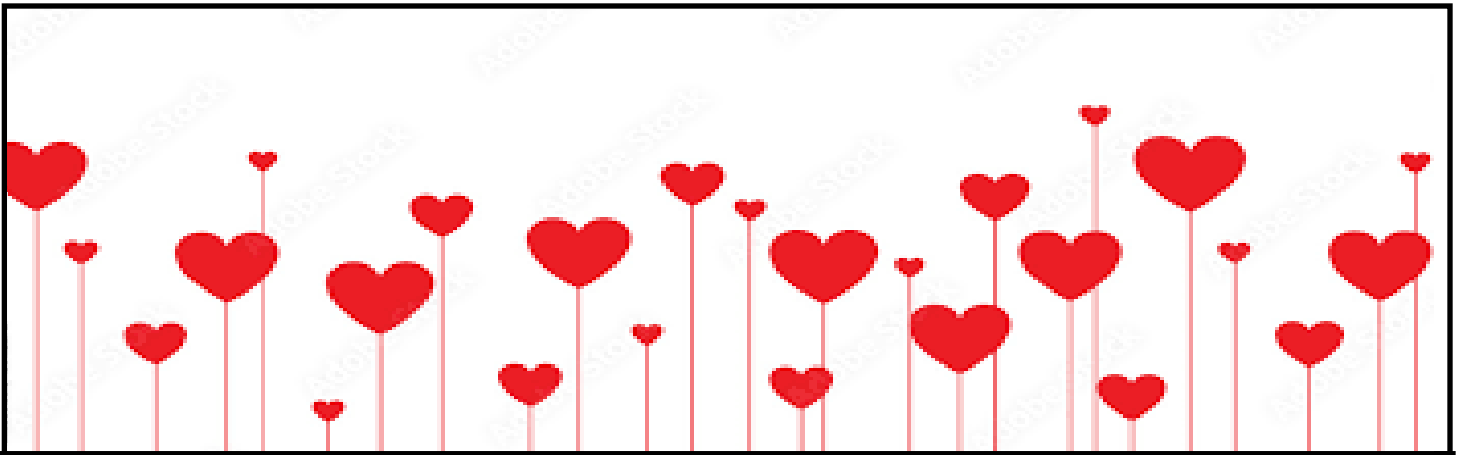
Sanctuary Flowers

Come to Buckin' Bean on Tuesday mornings at 9:00 am for coffee, conversation, and laughter!



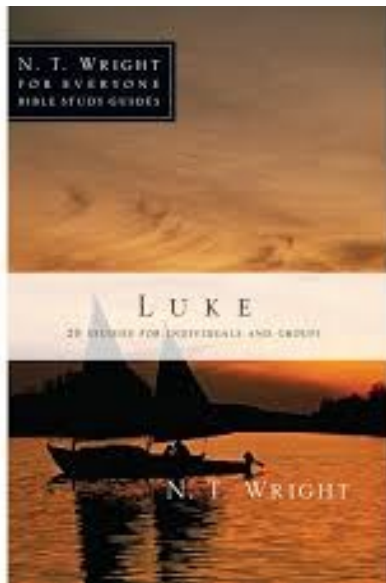
Adult Sunday School

I covet your prayers, your love, and your support. I could not ask to be the pastor of a better congregation. Please, also remember, that even while I walk this new journey, I am still your pastor. Please don't feel like I have "enough on my plate," so you don't want to burden me. I love being your pastor and want to be with you in every aspect of ministry that I have been over the last four and a half years.

I am looking forward with Joy; Joy that my daughter is getting married at the end of this year, Joy that once we get my dad moved it will be a better living situation for him, Joy that when we have my moms' celebration of life it will be just that: a celebration of the good she always found in people, and the shining example she was of what unconditional love looked like.

I also want to encourage you to come to the Lenten services on Wednesday nights. The soups and fellowship before worship are always good and the worship is soul-nourishing. Our theme this year is Christian Unity and we are doing something a little differently. We want to answer your questions about Christian Unity.
