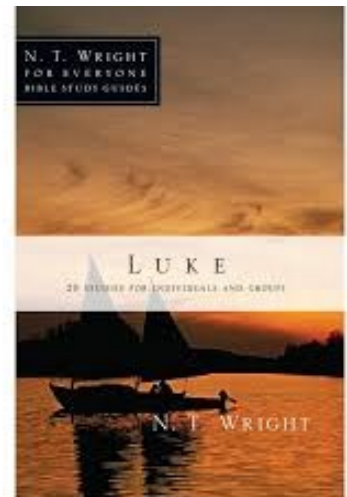
Ladies Scrapbooking Group

We know that life has a rhythm to it. The goats are along the river, and this weekend is Jackalope Jamboree. These seem to be the signal that summer has truly begun. 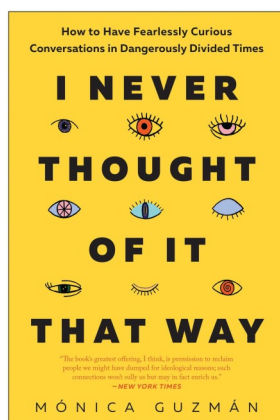
