Come to Buckin' Bean on Tuesday mornings at 9:00 am for coffee, conversation, and laughter!



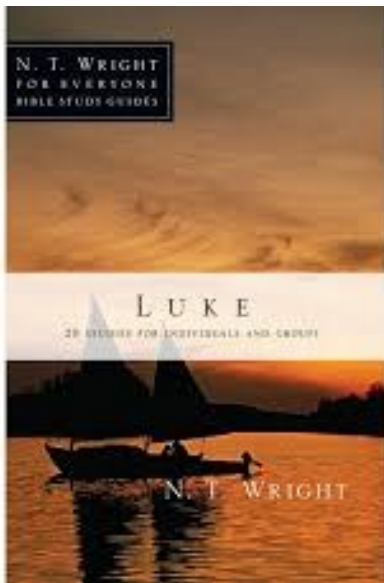

## Karyn's Kwips

For our Lent series this year, we are going back to our roots. Lent was originally a season for new converts to learn and prepare for their baptism on Easter. During that time, they would study what was central to Christianity. They studied what was central to Jesus' life and ministry: radical welcome, love for neighbor, care for the vulnerable, nourishment for the hungry, nonviolence in the face of injustice.

Throughout Lent, we will be looking at some of Jesus' ministry moments and teachings looking for Good News, so we can share the Good News with others.

I was going to write something about the big picture of the Good News we get to share; however, I think Rev. Anna Strickland (one of the contributors to the Lenten materials) said it so well I decided to share her words with you instead. "The Good News is about a God who loves humanity so deeply They took on flesh and bone to be with us. It's about the power of community and the need to care for one another, protect one another, and love one another. It's about the ways of the world being impermanent while the kingdom of God endures, even when that seems impossible. It's about a God who is creative, fluid, and always on the move, blessing diversity and calling it good. It's about a love so deep, so wide, so endless, that it overcomes even death. Most days the good news feels impossible, foolish even. But despite it all, I believe. Despite it all, I claim the name of Christ."

This Lent, we remember that the Good News really is good news. It is joyful—like fine wine saved for celebration. It grows like a mustard seed and smells like perfume poured from an alabaster jar. It tastes like bread passed endlessly through a hungry crowd. It sounds like laughter and feels like mercy. The good news is alive in the world.
