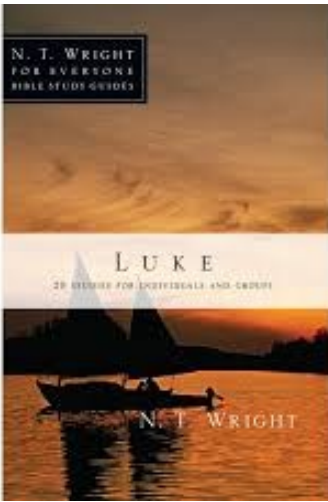
June Potluck

I'm excitedly awaiting your questions.

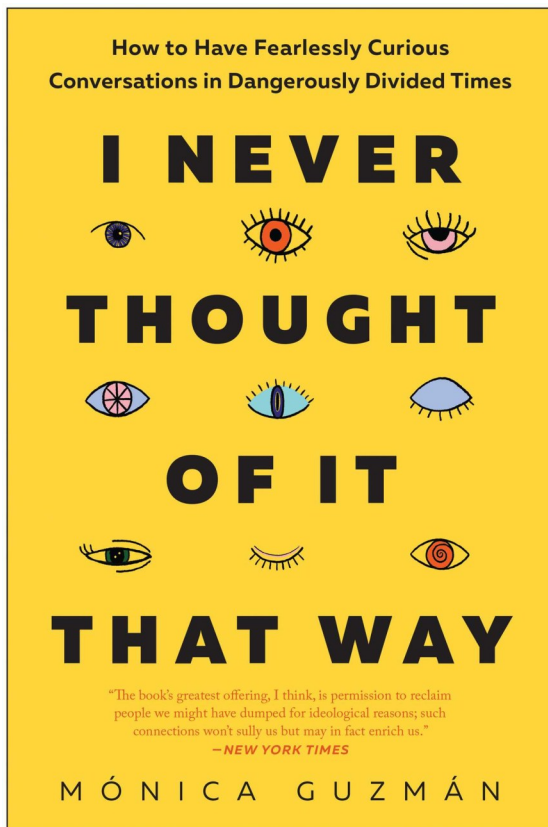
