In Chile the official funds for purchasing is the peso. We have bills of one thousand, 2 thousand, 5 thousand, 10 thousand and 20 thousand. Coins of 10 pesos, 50 pesos and 100 pesos.

The value of the dollar fluctuates daily due to market fluctuations.

Remember to make your land transportations reservations days before travel and to receive confirmation that your message was received.

Also the same applies to the tours. This agency will handle both the tours and the transport but each activity requires reservations. The organizing committee does not have anything to do with these issues.

Suggestion: Travel with accident insurance, this is the fastest manner in which to receive the assistance you will need.

Days before your arrival, we will advise you of the weather conditions. In October we have Spring but along the coast it is much cooler.
