

## Position Overview

Gymfinity International coaches support athletes across all stages of development, from beginner and recreational classes to advanced training and competitive programs, while contributing to our mission of building confident athletes within a positive gym family community.

We are seeking motivated and enthusiastic instructors who are passionate about teaching dance and supporting athlete development. Instructors work collaboratively with program directors and staff to deliver high-quality training and create a safe, positive learning environment.

This role focuses on athletic and performance-based dance styles, including jazz, hip hop, pom, and collegiate dance styles, with opportunities to work with both recreational and competitive dancers.

Positions begin under Germany's mini-job (tax-free) employment status during the initial training period, with opportunities to remain in this role or progress to part-time.

## Key Responsibilities

- Lead or assist dance classes and training sessions appropriate to assigned programs
  - Teach technical dance skills, choreography, and performance elements in styles such as jazz, hip hop, pom, or collegiate dance
  - Create a safe, positive, and supportive training environment for dancers while developing performance quality and confidence
  - Assist with class setup, music coordination, and maintaining an organized studio space
  - Communicate professionally and positively with athletes, parents, and staff
  - Follow Gymfinity coaching standards and safety procedures while contributing to a collaborative coaching team

## Qualifications

- Ability to teach in English
  - Experience working with **youth athletes or dancers** (for Junior Instructors, experience as a youth dancer)
  - Background in competitive dance, collegiate dance teams, or professional dance environments and experience in jazz, hip hop, pom, or similar performance-based dance disciplines
  - Strong communication skills and ability to work collaboratively within a coaching team
  - Ability to work with children and athletes in a structured training environment
  - Enthusiastic and positive coaching style with commitment to whole-athlete development
  - Comfortable physically supporting athletes and demonstrating choreography and dance technique
  - Commitment to personal health and fitness, and a desire to help foster that commitment in future generations of athletes

## Compensation

Gymfinity International offers a structured compensation system that rewards experience, responsibility, and professional development. All new instructors begin with a short training period under Germany's mini-job employment status, paid at the German minimum wage, before transitioning to their assigned classes with an adjusted pay rate. Additional pay increases apply for coaching/dance teaching certifications, relevant university degrees, and professional dance or collegiate dance team experience.

Gymfinity's compensation structure is designed to support long-term coaching careers and advancement within the organization and the sport.

## Work Authorization

Gymfinity International is a German company (GmbH). Applicants must have legal authorization to work in Germany, such as EU citizenship, EU residency rights, SOFA status, or a valid German work visa. EU citizens and individuals with SOFA status do not require a separate work visa. Applicants with other citizenship statuses must secure appropriate work authorization prior to employment.
