

Position Overview

Gymfinity International instructors and teachers support children across all stages of development while contributing to our mission of building confident young learners within a positive gym family community.

We are seeking enthusiastic and nurturing preschool teachers who are passionate about early childhood development, movement-based learning, and creating engaging educational environments for young children.

Moonwalkers Preschool serves children ages 3–5 in an active, play-based learning environment that blends movement, gymnastics, social-emotional development, and early academic concepts. Teachers work collaboratively with program directors and staff to deliver a safe, structured, and engaging program that supports children’s physical, intellectual, emotional, and social development.

The Moonwalkers program integrates gymnastics-based movement, themed learning units, hands-on activities, and early STEAM concepts throughout the day. Teachers guide children through both small-group and large-group activities designed to build confidence, curiosity, and a love of learning.

Positions begin under Germany’s mini-job (tax-free) employment status during the initial training period, with opportunities to remain in this role or progress to part-time.

Key Responsibilities

- Lead or assist preschool sessions within the Moonwalkers and Stars programs for children ages 3–6
- Facilitate play-based learning activities that incorporate movement, exploration, and hands-on educational experiences

- Integrate early academic concepts, including pre-reading, early math, critical thinking, and STEAM-based learning, into daily activities
 - Support and supervise children during gymnastics movement classes, themed games, and structured play
 - Foster children's social-emotional development, encouraging teamwork, communication, confidence, and independence
 - Guide children through themed learning units and activities that promote creativity and exploration
 - Maintain a safe, structured, and positive classroom and gym environment at all times
 - Work collaboratively with other instructors in large and small group formats while providing individualized attention
 - Communicate professionally and positively with parents, families, and staff
 - Assist with classroom setup, cleaning, activity preparation, and maintaining organized learning and gym spaces
 - Follow Gymfinity teaching standards, safety procedures, and preschool program guidelines

Qualifications

- Ability to teach and communicate clearly in English
 - Experience working with young children in preschool, childcare, early education, gymnastics, dance, or youth activity programs
 - Passion for early childhood development and play-based learning
 - Strong communication skills and ability to work collaboratively with a teaching team
 - Enthusiastic and patient teaching style with a focus on nurturing children's confidence and curiosity
 - Comfortable supervising children in both classroom and movement-based environments
 - Ability to assist children with basic needs and maintain a safe learning environment

Compensation

Gymfinity International offers a structured compensation system that rewards experience, responsibility, and professional development.

All new teachers begin with a short training period under Germany's mini-job employment status, paid at the German minimum wage, before transitioning to their assigned schedule with an adjusted pay rate. Additional pay increases may apply for relevant education degrees, early childhood certifications, or coaching certifications.

Gymfinity's compensation structure is designed to support long-term careers and professional development within the organization and youth programs.

Work Authorization

Gymfinity International is a German company (GmbH). Applicants must have legal authorization to work in Germany, such as EU citizenship, EU residency rights, SOFA status, or a valid German work visa. EU citizens and individuals with SOFA status do not require a separate work visa. Applicants with other citizenship statuses must secure appropriate work authorization prior to employment.
