# How to Measure Your Cabinets

Accurate measurements are the key to ensuring your new doors & drawer fronts fit seamlessly. Don't worry, the process is simple, and you'll just need a tape measure, a notepad, and a few minutes of your time.

## Step 1: Measure the Opening

Measure the inside width and height of the cabinet frame opening (the clear space where the door will cover). Use a tape measure and be sure to measure in inches to the nearest 1/16" for accuracy. Write down both the width and the height — these will be the base numbers you use for your door size calculation.



## Step 2: Choose Your Overlay

The overlay is how much the door will cover past the cabinet opening. The most common choice is ½", which means the door extends ½" past the opening on every side.

## Step 3: Calculate Your Door Size

### Single Door:

Add ½" overlay to each side of the opening, both width and height.

**Example:** A 24" W × 24" H opening with ½" overlay becomes a 25" W × 25" H door.

**Note:** *Single doors should not be wider than 25".*



### Two Doors (Split Door):

Start the same way (add ½" overlay to each side), then divide the width by 2. For a small gap between doors, subtract 1/16" from each.

**Example:** A 24" W × 24" H opening with ½" overlay becomes two 12 ½" W × 25" H doors. With a ⅛" center gap, each door would be 12 7/16" W × 25" H.

**Note:** *Always order two doors for a split opening.*

## Measuring Tips

Measure twice to ensure accuracy. Label each measurement with cabinet location or number, and record drawer fronts separately.
