To prepare a rough estimate, we just need a few basic details about your space. Measurements do not need to be exact. Approximate is completely fine.

Windows, Doors & Fixed Elements

Tell us about anything that may interrupt cabinetry:

- Window locations and rough size
- Doorways and openings
- Beams, soffits, posts, floor vents, or other fixed elements

If it cannot move, we should know about it.

Appliances, Plumbing & Venting

Let us know what is going into the space:

- Refrigerator width
- Range or cooktop size
- Wall oven or microwave
- Dishwasher
- Sink location
- Gas line or hood vent location

Overall Space

Start with the basics:

- Ceiling height
- Rough wall lengths where cabinetry may go
- Let us know if ceilings are vaulted or sloped
- Note if cabinets will go to the ceiling

It can be helpful to include a rough drawing of your space as well.

Depth Matters

Depth is commonly missed. Please include:

- Depth of alcoves or recessed areas
- Distance from wall to island space
- Narrow pantry or niche depths

Depth helps us avoid guessing and keeps your estimate more accurate.

Photos

Please include clear photos of your space:

- Straight on photos of each wall
- Ceiling and floor areas
- Corner views of the space
- Any areas of damage or remodeling
- Inspiration photos so we understand your style preferences, layout goals, and overall vision.

A NOTE ABOUT YOUR ESTIMATE

Your estimate is a starting point based on the information provided. If no Collection is selected, we prepare your estimate using our Signature Collection as a baseline.

Estimates help determine whether your project aligns with your budget. Selections and pricing may adjust as details are refined.

Exact appliance models are not required at this stage. Approximate sizes are sufficient.
