FEAST OF OUR LADY OF PERPETUAL HELP: A MOTHER WHO NEVER STOPS HELPING

Each year on June 27, the Church celebrates the Feast of Our Lady of Perpetual Help, a beloved Marian devotion that has brought comfort, hope, and spiritual strength to millions of Catholics around the world. This feast reminds us that Mary, the Mother of Jesus, continues to accompany her children with a mother's loving care, leading us always to her Son.

The devotion is centered on a revered Byzantine icon dating from the fifteenth century. The image depicts the Blessed Virgin Mary holding the Child Jesus while the archangels Michael and Gabriel present the instruments of His future Passion. In the icon, the young Jesus looks toward these signs of suffering and seeks refuge in His Mother's arms. Mary, however, gazes outward toward us, inviting all believers to place their trust in God's mercy and in her loving intercession.

The history of the icon is remarkable. After being brought from Crete to Rome in the late fifteenth century, it was venerated for centuries before eventually coming into the care of the Redemptorist Fathers. In 1866, Pope Pius IX entrusted the icon to the Redemptorists with the famous instruction: "Make her known throughout the world." Through their missionary efforts, devotion to Our Lady of Perpetual Help spread across continents and continues to flourish today through parish novenas, processions, and personal prayer.



For many Catholics, Our Lady of Perpetual Help is a source of consolation during times of illness, family struggles, grief, financial hardship, and uncertainty. Her title reminds us that God's grace is always available and that Mary continually intercedes for all who seek her aid. Weekly novenas dedicated to Our Lady of Perpetual Help remain among the most popular Marian devotions in the Church, reflecting the deep faith of those who turn to her in prayer.

As we celebrate this feast, let us renew our confidence in the maternal care of the Blessed Virgin Mary. May we imitate her faith, trust in God's providence, and bring our needs to her with confidence. Through her prayers and loving intercession, may we draw ever closer to Jesus Christ, our Redeemer.

O Mother of Perpetual Help, with the greatest confidence we come before your holy image. Obtain for us the grace to remain faithful to your Son and to trust in God's loving care in every circumstance of life. Help us to follow Jesus with courage and joy, and pray for us now and always. Amen.
